

ISU ANTI-DOPING PROGRAM: SEASON 2021-22

TESTING

During the season 2021-22, more than **2000 samples** were collected on **857 Skaters** (387 women and 470 Men) from **54 Nationalities**.

139 Skaters were included in the ISU RTP/TP, this is the highest since 2018/19 and is partially due to the OWG 2022.

The volume of **In-Competition (IC) urine testing has increased** as the season 2021/22 was almost a full season, it's getting back to average number of tests done before the pandemic. Anti-Doping Testing was conducted at **all maintained ISU Events** (Figure Skating: 18, Speed Skating 12, Short Track: 6, Synchronized Skating: 2) respecting strong sanitary measures imposed by COVID-19 pandemic.

The number of **OOB tests has increased** compared to the last 3 years individual figures.

All Skaters participating at the ISU World Cup Speed Skating 1-OWG QC (**261 Skaters**), ISU World Cup Short Track 4-OWG QC (**226 Skaters**) and ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships (**142 Skaters**) had to undergo an ABP-Blood Testing prior to the competition.

The Hematological and Steroidal Passports of the Skaters who had potential chances to qualify for the OWG 2022 and have samples kept in Long Term Storage have been reviewed to select those samples to be reanalysed for ESA.

The **reanalyses of 17 Speed Skaters samples** and **18 Short Track Skaters samples** were performed. All results were reported as Negative.

The breakdown of the testing for in and out-of-competition and type of testing is reported in **Appendix #1**.

CASE MANAGEMENT

6 AAFs were reported by **ISU Members**, **5** were considered as **ADRV** and **1** was reported **Negative** due to a **valid TUE**.

1 AAF was reported by **MEO** and was considered as **ADRV**.

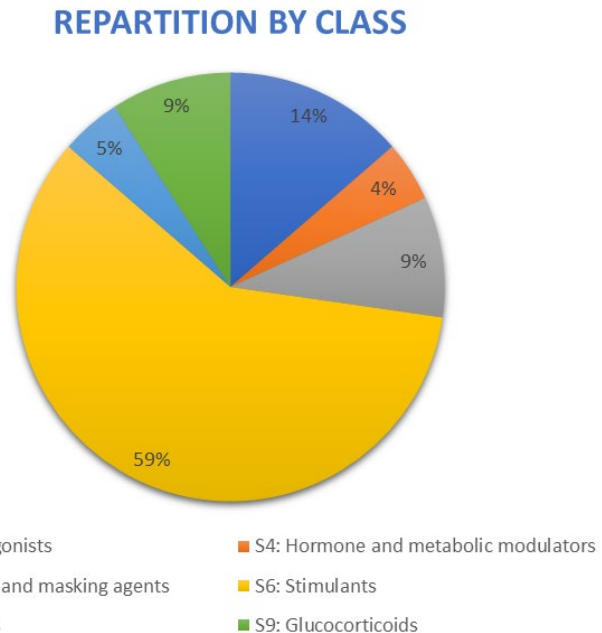
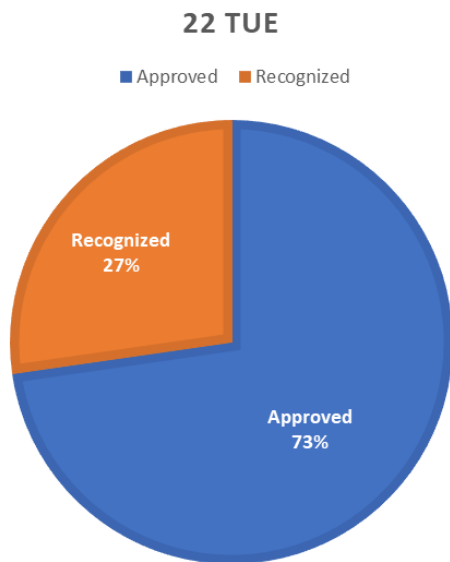
Class Substances leading to ADRV are **S1.1; S5, S4 & S6**.
