ISU COE JOINT CAMP SERIES 2026 – CHAMPÉRY

The ISU Centres of Excellence in Champéry, Oberstdorf, and Bergamo, supported by ISU Development, proudly present a series of joint training camps, providing a unique training opportunity tailored for single skaters at the Advanced Novice and Junior levels and their coaches from countries currently developing their programs. The camps aim to foster skill development, technique refinement, and rules understanding in the sport of figure skating.

Content	Participants will receive a comprehensive training program including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 6 master classes (50 min. each), covering selected topics such as Steps and Turns, Spins, Jumping Technique, and Choreography• 12 semiprivate lessons (25 min. each, up to 3 skaters)• 12 free ice sessions (25 min. each)• 6 ballet and musical classes• 6 specific off-ice training sessions• 5 theory classes, covering various important topics, such as ISU Regulations and Judging System, Athlete Lifestyle, Planning, and Strategy

In addition, participating coaches will have one dedicated session per day, either on or off the ice, to exchange with the instructors.

Price CHF 250 per skater
CHF 150 per coach

The price includes lunch, tuition, ice, and use of the equipment and the facilities. Participants are responsible for arranging their own travel, breakfast, and dinner.

Note Skaters are supervised only during trainings and the presence of a responsible adult outside these times is therefore mandatory.

Applications will be considered on a first-come, first-serve basis, following direct submission by Member Federations. **The entry deadline is 18 May 2026.** Confirmations will be sent within 5 business days. The payment details will be sent to the admitted participants.

ADMISSIONS

The number of participants is limited to a maximum of 24 skaters and 12 coaches.

The skaters will be divided in two groups of up to 12.

Each Member Federation can apply for up to 4 skaters and 2 coaches.

Applying coaches must be training at least one skater participating in the camp.

Due to the limited availability, we cannot guarantee that all applications will be accepted.
