# C.o.E. Development Joint Camps

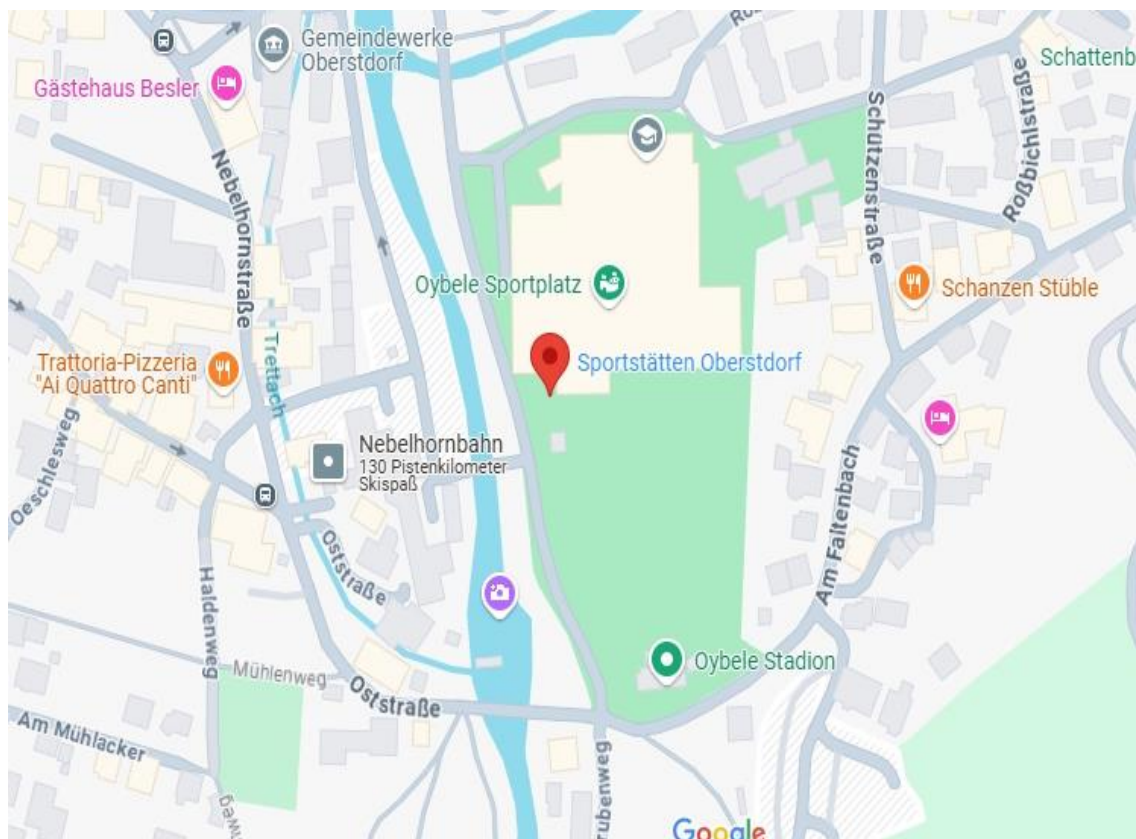

**Ria Schiffner & Niko Ulanovsky** (ISU COE Oberstdorf)

Ria and Niko coach a number of upcoming talents at the ISU Center of Excellence in Oberstdorf; among others, they are the coaches of Genrikh Gartung, who has won several medals at the ISU Junior Grand Prix competitions and is the reigning German champion.

## Training Program Highlights

Participants will receive a comprehensive training programme that includes the following:

- 12 master classes (50 minutes each) on various selected topics such as steps and turns, spins, jump technique...
- 6 free ice training sessions (50 minutes each)
- 6 off-ice dance classes
- 6 specific off-ice exercise classes
- Theory lessons on various useful topics, e.g. ISU rules and scoring system, Personal Development Plan...

**Notes: Skaters are supervised only during trainings and the presence of a responsible adult outside these times is therefore mandatory.**

# Assessment and Selection

The number of participants is limited to a maximum of 24 skaters. The skaters are divided into two groups of up to 12 athletes each. Smaller subgroups are formed for some specific training sessions. Candidates are assessed and selected by the ISU Development Commission and a committee of coaches from the three participating centres.

## Participant cost

- 250 Euro per skater (includes tuition, ice, use of the facilities)
- 130 Euro per coach (includes attending to all the lessons on and off ice)
