DECLARATION FOR COMPETITORS AND OFFICIALS ENTERING ISU EVENTS

(This Communication cancels and replaces ISU Communication No. 1628)

Each competitor, Official and Member must sign a Declaration form confirming familiarity with and acceptance of the ISU Statutes governing participation in ISU Events and activities. Such declaration forms are intended as explicit reminders of certain of the comprehensive provisions of the ISU Statutes and Council decisions applicable to and binding upon all participants in ISU competitions and activities. In case of competitors who have not reached the age of 18, such Declaration must be co-signed by at least one of the parents or other legal guardian.

For the competitors and Officials entered by the ISU Members (judges, team leaders, team doctors, physiotherapists, coaches, choreographers and team officials), the Declaration forms for each person must be returned by the Members to the ISU Secretariat annually, as soon as possible as of July 1 every season but latest two (2) weeks prior to the competitor's or Official's first competition of the season.

For Officials appointed to ISU Events by the ISU (ISU or International Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data/Replay Operators, Starters, Competitor Stewards) the form can be returned to the ISU Secretariat directly by the Officials and does not require the Member's signature. The signed Declaration may be uploaded into the ORS:

For Synchronized Skating Events, the Declaration shall be signed by the Team Captain on behalf of all members of the Team. It is the responsibility of the Member and Team Captain to make the Team members familiar with the Declaration.
