Guidance to the Racing Rules in Short Track for the Season 2026-2027

Based on Rule 295, paragraph 2 of the ISU Sports Rules Short Track 2026, an updated version of the Guidance to the Racing Rules in Short Track is herewith communicated.

The Guidance provides for a uniform handling of infringements of the Short Track Racing Rules by Referees and intends to assist Coaches and Skaters in their tactical preparation for racing to avoid situations that can lead to sanctions.

In addition, the Guidance undertakes to help interested persons for a better understanding of the Racing Rules for Short Track.
