

Communication No. 2815

Officials' Remuneration for ISU Events

This Communication replaces Communication No. 2096 with immediate effect.

As of season 2026/27, the ISU will transfer the respective amounts to the Officials concerned, except for the Judges of the Figure Skating Branch for whom the organizing ISU Members/Organizing Committee (OC) will remain responsible to pay the respective amount.

A. Figure Skating Branch

1. On-site Officials:

ISU appointed Officials will receive the following remuneration:

- a) Senior & Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating events
& Final, World Team Trophy: USD 380 per event
- b) ISU Figure Skating (Single & Pair Skating/Ice Dance) Championships:
 - i) Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers,
Data & Replay Operators,
Technical Panel Advisor*: USD 570 per event
 - ii) Referees, Judges: USD 500 per event
- c) ISU Synchronized Skating Championships:
 - i) Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers,
Data & Replay Operators,
Technical Panel Advisor*: USD 320 per event
 - ii) Referees, Judges: USD 260 per event

All amounts are "gross amounts" and must be paid either in US Dollars or in the currency of the organizing ISU Member, provided it is a hard currency. This money is to be distributed at Registration to all Judges. Payment of the honorarium to ISU Appointed Officials (Referee, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators, Technical Panel Advisor and OAC Members) will be done directly by the ISU.

** When the TPA role is performed by the Technical Committee Representative, the remuneration does not apply.*

2. OAC Members:

Men, Women, Pair Skating, Ice Dance and Synchronized Skating will be considered separately for reimbursement. Remuneration per OAC Member, per discipline will be as follows:

- USD 400
 - ISU Senior Grand Prix
 - ISU World Team Trophy
 - Winter Youth Olympic Games
 - ISU Challenger Series in Synchronized Skating
- USD 600
 - ISU Junior Grand Prix
- USD 800
 - ISU European Figure Skating Championships
 - ISU Four Continent Figure Skating Championships
 - ISU World Junior Figure Skating Championships
 - ISU World Figure Skating Championships
 - ISU World Junior Synchronized Skating Championships
 - ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships
 - Olympic Winter Games

Remuneration per event for OAC members analyzing national bias:

- USD 500 all disciplines in the event

B. Speed Skating Branch

ISU appointed Officials will receive the following remuneration:

ISU Speed Skating Championships and ISU Speed Skating
World Cup: USD 400 per event

ISU Speed Skating Junior World Cup: USD 260 per event

For ISU Short Track Championships, World Tour and Junior World Cup, remuneration is paid in accordance with the individual agreements between the ISU and the Officials concerned.

All amounts are “gross amounts” and must be paid either in US Dollars or in the currency of the organizing ISU Member, provided it is a hard currency.
