ISU Athletes' Committee Elections Results

The ISU Athletes' Committee elections have been concluded, with the newly elected members (see [Communication 2772](#)) beginning their four-year terms on June 13, 2026, following the 60th Ordinary ISU Congress in Tenerife (ESP).

The Chair of the Athletes' Committee holds a seat on the ISU Council, ensuring that the voices and perspectives of the skaters are represented in the ongoing governance of the sport, in line with the ISU's long-term strategy [Vision 2030](#).

Here below is an overview of the voting results by discipline:

Speed Skating

Total votes cast: 68

- Ivanie Blondin (CAN): 30
- Fridtjof Petzold (GER): 21
- Douwe De Vries (NED): 17

Short Track

Total votes cast: 39

- Viktor Knoch (HUN): 15
- Alang Kim (KOR): 12
- Dajing Wu (CHN): 7
- Edin Brankovic (BIH): 5

Figure Skating Pairs

Total votes cast: 6

- Deanna Stellato Dudek (CAN): 3
- Wenjing Sui (CHN): 3

As the vote resulted in a tie, and as only one athlete per country may be elected to the Athletes Committee, Ms. Ivanie Blondin fulfils this quota based on the Speed Skating election results. The elected candidate for Figure Skating - Pairs is therefore Ms. Wenjing Sui from China.

Synchronized Skating

Total votes cast: 60

- Jára Judit Jászonyi (HUN): 21
- Smetine Tia Kurath (SUI): 12
