1 GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Skate Berlin International 2026** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Skate Berlin International 2026** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

3 RESULTS AND DRAWS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

The draws for the first competition segments (Short Program, Rhythm Dance, Pattern Dances) will be held at least one day before the start of the respective category in accordance with ISU rule 513, 1.

Starting orders of the Free Skating / Free Dance will be the reverse order of the result after the Short Program/Rhythm Dance or Pattern Dances (ISU rule 513, 2).

The location for the draws will be announced in due time prior to the competition.

4 ENTRIES

4.1 General

All entries for the **Skate Berlin International 2026**, must be done through the **ISU Online Registration System (ORS)** by the deadline indicated. Declarations will need to be uploaded to the ORS as well.

4.2 Preliminary Entries

The Preliminary Entries must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) not later than: **Monday, December 22, 2025 – 20:00 (CET)**.

4.3 Entries by Name

4.3.1 Entries of Competitors

All ISU Member Federations may register a maximum of 3 entries per category. However, the organizing ISU Member Deutsche Eislauf-Union (Germany) is allowed to register a higher number of entries.

In case the number of entries is too high, the organizer has the right to reduce the number of participants. Preference will be given to those ISU Members which submitted preliminary entries, in order of receipt of such entries.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries in case the number of entries are too high. If the Organizing Committee must limit these numbers, priority will be given to those countries who have completed the preliminary entry.

Entries of Competitors by name must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS): **Monday, January 19, 2026 – 20:00 (CET)**.

4.3.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate one (1) judge who has at least has the qualification "Judge for International Competitions". ISU Members with entries in the Singles and Pairs as well as Ice Dance categories may enter two (2) judges. If possible, preference when nominating judges shall be given to judges with qualification for both Singles and Pairs and Ice Dance.

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such a draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such a draw.

The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) not later than: **Monday, January 19, 2026 – 20:00 (CET)**.

4.3.3 Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one Coach per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Only two Team Officials of each Member, including the Member President provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation, will be accredited. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation. An accompanying person to a Judge will only be accepted for accreditation if this person is a partner in life or a relative of the Judge. The Member Federations guarantee that the requested accreditation of Team Members will correspond to their function within the team and the Federation.

The entry of Team delegation must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) not later than: **Monday, January 19, 2026 – 20:00 (CET).**

4.4 Entry Fee

The following entry fee must be paid:

- 100.00 € for each Skater in singles categories
- 100.00 € for each Pair in Basic Novice
- 160.00 € for each Pair in Advanced Novice, Junior or Senior and all Ice Dance categories

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

All participants which have been confirmed by January 22, 2026, must transfer the entry fee by no later than **January 30, 2026.**

Payments received after the payment deadline on January 30, 2026 will be charged with an additional fee of +25%.

In case the entry fee has not been received to the BEV before the competition in full, the participation of the respective competitor(s) or federation can be declined or a 100% increased entry fee must be paid in cash (Euro only) at the time of registration on site at the competition in the organizing committees office.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

5 EVENT OFFICIAL

All Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists as well as Data and Replay Operators will be appointed by the organizer in line with the principles of rule 420, paragraphs 5.b), 6 of the ISU Special Regulations Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 as well as ISU Communication 2699, paragraph 4 for appointing the Event Officials.

6 MEALS, ACCOMMODATION AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for travel, accommodation and meals for all appointed Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists as well as Data and Replay Operators in accordance with their time of service at the competition.

For Judges, officially approved for the competition, the Organizing Committee will cover the accommodation costs and providing meals in accordance with the time of service at the competition, in general starting from the day prior to the first day a judge is officiating until breakfast the day after the individual judge's last Round Table Discussion.

All other people registered for the competition (Competitors, Coaches, other Team Delegation members) are obliged to bear all costs for travel, accommodation and meals by themselves.

7 PRACTICE

The organizer will offer limited practice times for all competitors prior and during the competition starting from Monday, February 16, 2026. Requests for practice prior to February 16, 2026 shall be made via mail to sbi@eissport-berlin.de.

Please note: Practice sessions may not be at the competition rink.

8 MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed: the ISU Member is responsible for submitting their competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (music.sbi@eissport-berlin.de) until **Monday, February 9, 2026**.

Please note:

Some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

Please note:

Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

In case the music files have not been submitted in time to the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

No accreditation card will be issued to any competitor until the music files have been received and confirmed by the Organizing Committee.

The music files will be temporarily stored for the duration of competitions to be able to play it back on the competition by computer. With the transmission, you allow the processing of the music exclusively for playback purposes for the performance of the nominated athlete.

The "Program Content Sheet" must also be submitted before the competition via the ISU PORTAL. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

9 ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the competition venue Sportforum Berlin – Hohenschönhausen upon arrival.

Chaperons will not receive accreditation. Chaperones must purchase event tickets onsite to enter the competition venue.

10 PUBLICATIONS AND RESULTS

All competition results as well as photos & videos (including livestream) of the competition will be published online.

With the nomination for the competition, the participants or their legal representatives agree to the publication. Please consider the separate note on the last page!

The organizer may share a Link for the Sportity App for information and publication of results.

11 PRESENTATION OF TROPHIES AND CERTIFICATES

The three best placed Skaters/Couples in each category will be announced and honored in a victory ceremony at the competition venue. The three best placed Skaters/Couples will receive a trophy.

All participants will receive a certificate.

12 INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must ensure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

13 EXHIBITION

The two best placed skaters/couples in the final ranking of each senior and junior category will be asked to take part in an exhibition on Saturday evening. Additional skaters/couples will be invited to participate. The invites will be published in the Sportity App after the competition of each discipline is finished.
