1. WELCOME

The Philippine Skating Union and the Organizing Committee are glad to invite you to participate in the Asian Open Figure Skating Trophy 2025.

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Asian Open Figure Skating Trophy 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, as well as the current ISU Rules and Regulations and ISU Communications valid for the Season 2025/2026.

Participation in the Asian Open Figure Skating Trophy 2025 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526: A Clearance Certificate is required for Skaters in the following circumstances:

 any Skater who is not a citizen of the ISU Member's country, whom the ISU Member intends to enter in ISU Championships, other ISU Events and/or International Competitions in the coming season,
any Skater who is a citizen of the ISU Member's country and who has in the past represented another ISU Member in ISU Championships, other ISU Events and/or in International Competitions, whom the ISU Member intends to enter in ISU Championships, other ISU Events and/or International Competitions in the coming season.

Competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials.

Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee.

The official announcement of the entries and of the panels of Officials is made by the Referee of each competition at the time of the first starting order draw of that competition.

STARTING ORDER FREE SKATING

In all categories in Free Skating the starting order will be reversed to the results after the Short Program. Draws will be published on the same day at **philippineskating.org**

4. ENTRIES

4.1. Entries of Competitors

All ISU members are eligible to nominate **3** competitors per category, except the Philippine Skating Union. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation/Association through the **ORS**. Link: <u>https://fsk-ors.isu.swisstiming.com/</u>

4.2 Preliminary Registration

5. ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

- USD 150 or PHP 8,700 singles categories with only one (1) program to perform
- USD 180 or PHP 10,440 singles categories with two (2) programs to perform
- USD 200 or PHP 11,600 senior pairs category

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

After the final entry of **TUESDAY**; **JULY 1 2025**, **11:59PM (local Manila time)**, respective Member Federation will receive an email from <u>finance.phsu@gmail.com</u> for Entry fee. Entry fee must be paid within 5 business days after receiving invoices. After 5 business days nonpaid entries will be automatically removed/deleted.

Any late payments after the deadline will incur a **USD 30 late payment fee**.

6. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the: Referees, Judges (drawn), Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators beginning with **dinner July 31, 2025, until breakfast on Aug 5, 2025.**

The **travel expenses (flight and airport transfers)** will be covered only for Invited Referees, Technical Controller, Technical Specialist, Judges, and Data and Replay Operators.

The organizer will not be able to cover any expenses for competitors and team officials.

7. MUSIC/PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by sending the file(s) to <u>music.phsu@gmail.com</u> until JULY 18, 2025 (two weeks before the event). Any other format is not accepted.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1, the title of the file must show the Competition event, Competitor's name, the Nation, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate USB stick.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

Program content form is to be submitted through the ISU Portal.

Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.

The three best placed skaters in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists from all categories. All participants will receive a certificate with their placement. The exact time of the Award Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please make sure that all skaters are represented well-dressed at the Awarding Ceremony.
