for Men, Women and Ice Dance

1. **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

The *Denkova–Staviski Cup 2025* will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024/2025, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Denkova–Staviski Cup 2025** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

2. TECHNICAL DATA:

2.1. PLACE OF THE COMPETITION:

Winter Sports Palace – Studentski grad District, Academician Boris Stefanov Str., Sofia, Bulgaria (an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 60 x 30 m, air-conditioned and heated).

2.2. CATEGORIES:

SENIOR LADIES & MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2024 and respective ISU Communication.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

SENIOR ICE DANCE

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice dance 2024 and respective ISU Communication.

Rhythm Dance: 2 min 50 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Dance: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR LADIES & MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice dance 2024 and respective ISU Communication.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR ICE DANCE

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2024 and respective ISU Communication.

Rhythm Dance: 2 min 50 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Dance: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

3. ENTRIES:

Competitors must be entered through their Member Federation.

In case of too many entries, the organiser reserves the right to limit the number of participants as follows:

- Junior Women 36
- Junior Men 24
- Junior Ice Dance 10
- Senior Women 24
- Senior Men 24
- Senior Ice Dance 10

The organizer will not cover any expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches, or chaperons.

4. CANCELLATION:

Cancellation of the competitor entry must be done till <u>October 27, 2025</u>. For any latter cancellation the team leader of respective Federation or Club will be asked to pay the entry fee.

5. JUDGES:

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge. The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) and reach the Organizing Committee, not later than **October 17**, **2025**.

The Panels will be drawn after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw.

Each panel of Judges in Seniors and Juniors categories will consist of 5 Judges.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators and confirmed Judges at *VITOSHA Park Hotel*****, beginning with dinner on Tuesday, November 04, 2025, until lunch on Monday, November 10, 2025.

Travel expenses will be covered only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

6. ENTRY FEE:

For Seniors and Juniors – € 95 per skater.

For Seniors and Juniors Ice dance – € 125 per couple.

Payment shall be made by bank transfer before the entry deadline.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason after the cancellation date.

When payment is made after the deadline or on spot during the accreditation, entry fee is:

- Seniors and Juniors € 120 per skater.
- Seniors and Juniors Ice dance € 150 per couple.

7. *MUSIC:*

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations Technical Rules Single Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- The participating member is responsible for submitting the Competitor's music as attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (music@bsf.bg) until October 17, 2025. Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.
- Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment, and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

- The music files must be sent as MP3 file format. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader / Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format of MP3 file).

8. CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS:

Results for all categories will be calculated using the new ISU Judging System. The results and any additional information for the event you can find on http://cup.clubdenkovastaviski.com.

9. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES:

The three best placed Skaters in each event will be announced and honoured. Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be presented to the medallists. All skaters will receive a diploma.

10. LIABILITY:

According to ISU regulations, the Event Organizer accepts no liability for bodily harm, personal injury and loss of property or damages incurred by any competitor(s) or official(s).

11. ACCREDITATION:

The accreditation will start on <u>Tuesday, November 04, 2025, at 15:00 h</u>. in the office of the Organizing Committee at the Winter Sports Palace.

Operating hours in competition days will be from 8:00h to 20:00 h.

12. DRAW:

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held on Thursday, November 06, 2025.

The exact place and time will be published in the official detailed schedule.

Starting order for the free skating/dance of categories Juniors and Seniors will be in reverse order of the results of short program.

13. ADDITIONAL PRACTICE:

Rates for additional practice hours are as follow:

1-hour open practice together with another teams – € 25 per skater.
