1.GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Challenge Cup will be conducted following the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Challenge Cup is for skaters who belong to an ISU Member, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must present an ISU Clearance Certificate.

All competitors must be entered through the ISU online registration system ORS by their respective ISU Member Federation.

3. Entries

3.1 Entries of Competitors

Each ISU Member can enter **up to three (3)** skaters/couples in each category. Preference will be given to those ISU Members which sent entries by number, in order of receipt of such entries. A reserve-list will be kept up to date daily. In case of too many entries, the organizer may reduce the final entries.

All Entries must be made by the ISU Member concerned based on the regulations for ISU in Figure Skating 2025/26. All entries for the Challenge Cup, must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the deadline indicated. Travel information should also be entered into ORS:

b) Entries by Number

The preliminary entries must reach the Organizer by latest: **November 24, 2025 – 20:00 h (CET)** by entering the information through the ORS.

c) Entries by Name

The Entries by names must be done through the ORS not later than December 19, 2025 - 20:00 h (CET).

d) Entry fee

An entry fee of \in 105, - per single skater (Adv. Novice/Junior/Senior), \in 80, - per Basic Novice skater and \in 180, - per pair/ice dance couple (Adv. Novice/Junior/Senior) will be asked and must be paid after confirmation of the official entry by name.

Invoices will be sent to the federations in advance.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals.

Applications received after the entry deadline will be increased to the following amounts:

€ 90, - per Basic Novice skater

€ 115, - per single skater (Adv. Novice/Junior/Senior)

€ 190, - per pair/ice dance couple

3.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one ISU or International Judge and one substitute Judge.

The Entries of Judges must be done through the ORS no later than December 19, 2025.

Each panel of Judges will consist of 5 judges. In case of a too high number of entered Judges, the Organizing Committee will make a draw and inform ISU Members before **January 5, 2026**, whether Judges have been drawn or not drawn. For the Ice Dance panel, priority will be given to Judges who are qualified as International- or ISU Judge in both Singles & Pairs and in Ice Dance.

3.3 Team Leaders meeting

There will be no team leaders meeting. All necessary information will be published in the Sportity app. We will create a groups app for all team leaders, so questions can be asked directly at the OC. Team leaders, please forward your mobile phone number by email to challengecup@knsb.nl. By sending this information you agree to the privacy policy.

3.4 Draw for starting order

The draw will be held online (online is approved by the ISU)-on **Wednesday January 21, at 15.00 (CET)** in presence of one of the Referees, in accordance with Rule 512 and 513 of the ISU Constitution and General Regulations. Competitors/official representatives are welcome to be present in person.

The draw can also be followed via the live stream.

The starting order for the Free Skating shall be based on the reverse order of the result of the Short Program.

4. OFFICIALS

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for Judges and invited Officials taking part, beginning on **January 21**, **2026**, **(dinner)** and ending on **January 25**, **2026**, **(lunch)** in accordance with their travel plans and scheduled activities.

5. PRACTICE

The official practices for competitors start on January 22, 2026 / appr. 08:00 hrs. The detailed schedule will be published in the Sportity app. There is also unofficial practise ice available. This schedule will also be published in the Sportity app in time.

6. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT / PRESS FORMS

Music.

All competitors shall offer competition music of excellent quality on MP3, M4A or WAV format, following Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations, paragraph 2. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Program for Single and Pairs, must be entered on the ISU Portal.

The Music files must be labelled with the following data:

- 1. Name of the ISU Member.
- 2. Name of the Competitor, category, and segment.
- 3. Exact running time (Not skating time) of the music, including any starting signal.

The competition music, only MP3, M4A or WAV format, must be send to music@challenge-cup.nl before the entry deadline of December 19, 2025.

Competitors must provide a backup drive (USB stick) for each program. This USB stick must also be labelled with all mentioned data. CD's will not be accepted by the OC.

<u>Please note</u>: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

If music information is not complete and provided as mentioned, accreditation will not be given.

Planned Program Content & Press forms.

The Planned Program Content, Music and Press forms must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform before the entry deadline of **December 19, 2025**. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

10. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Figure Skating Manager) as described in ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 will be in place.

11. MEDAL CEREMONY

The medal ceremony will take place at the end of the competition. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the winning athletes in each category.

The best placed team will be honoured with the International Challenge Cup. In case of a draw the highest number of first and/or second places will be considered.

For the National Championship, gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the winning athletes in each category.
