★ General Regulations

25 - 28.09.2025

The Crystal Skate Open 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024 the Special Regulations Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Crystal Skate Open 2025 is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member and its member Clubs, and qualify for eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a). They meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

>VENUE:

Main Competition Rink: Tondiraba Ice Hall, Varraku tn. 14, Tallinn, Estonia (an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 58 x 28 m, air-conditioned and heated)

>A CLASS CATEGORIES:

Senior Men / Women

Short Program Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

The required elements to be skated are those listed in the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2025/26.

Free Skating Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced program" and the element value.

Junior Men / Women

Short Program Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec. The required elements to be skated are those listed in the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2025/26.

Free Skating Duration: 3 min., 30sec. +/- 10 sec.

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well-balanced program" and the element value.

>ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason. The entry fee is a registration prerequisite, failure to pay the entry fee by the deadline can result in a rejected or disqualified entry.

All Entry Fee payments received after 23:59 local time, September 5th, 2025 are subject to a late entry fee of 10€ per skater. The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation is substituting a skater, whose entry fee was paid by the deadline by another skater. The OC reserves the right to cancel the Entry of skaters whose entry fee has not been paid by the published deadline.

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee via e-mail: competitions@kristalluisk.ee.

The submission must be of a fine quality encoded in either MP3 or WAW format with normalised level audio. The OC cannot guarantee quality playback for music submitted in other than the above-mentioned format. Each music submission must also contain the name of the track, composer, singer and/or author in the Title field of the Online Registration form.

Competitors have the opportunity to validate their music either within the registration system before the event or at the OC Office / Accreditation Office at the Ice Rink.

Any music changes must be done latest 48h before the beginning of the first segment of the competition. Any later changes must be coordinated with the OC on-site.

In accordance to the Estonian Skating Federation rules as well as the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024 the Special Regulations Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 each skater and his/her lawful representative is solely responsible for the music rights and licenses for their program's music. The OC will take no responsibility for licensing the program/performance music.
