ANNOUNCEMENT

1. General regulations

The **Daugava Open Cup 2026** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2025, Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2025 and the relevant ISU Communications. Participation in the **Daugava Open Cup 2026** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. The OC can have a final decision about over quota for any club/country/federation or refuse to accept the entry (fully or partially).

PLACE: Daugavas Ledus Halle, Augsiela 1, Riga, Latvia, LV-1009.

(An indoor ice-rink with ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

3. ENTRIES OF COMPETITORS

3.1 General

All Entries to **Daugava Open Cup 2026** must be done through Sportity Online Registration System: <https://fs.sportity.com>. Any Clubs entering first time should contact Sportity OÜ for account creation (info@sportity.com).

Note: possible waiting for password from Sportity could be up to 3 days.

The deadline for entries is Monday, February 16th, 2026, 22:00 (local time Riga).

OC has an authority to enter skaters after deadline.

All the members of ISU being members of National Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to take part in this competition. It is possible to enter an unlimited number of skaters in each category. However, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse participation in the competition.

3.2. Entries of Judges



Each ISU Member may nominate one Judge for the competition.

Judges will be appointed by the Organizing Committee in cooperation with the Referee.

The draw of Judges for the panels will be conducted by the Organizing Committee according to ISU Regulations.

3.3. Entry Fee

100 EUR per skater 2 (two) programs (Advanced Novice) **Late Entry Fee: 115 EUR**

85 EUR per skater 1 (one) program **Late Entry Fee: 100 EUR**

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation. Bill must be paid with one (1) transaction for all the club/member participants. The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason.

IMPORTANT: In case of non-payment after the entry deadline, the skater will be placed on the waiting list and will be registered only after full payment is received.

3.4 Category Restrictions

Please note! Skaters who did participate in group A, B or C are not allowed to change to a lower category during the season (only with some exceptions consulting with referee and OC), violation of this rule may result in the cancellation of the competition results of the skater by the Organizing Committee or the Referee.

4. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms, meals and travel for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators and Judges participating, beginning with dinner on **Saturday, 14th March, 2026** until dinner on **Sunday, 15th March, 2026**.

Should any of the above-mentioned persons arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

5. EXTRA PAID PRACTICES

Extra paid practice for Competitors will be available **from Thursday, 12th March, 2026**.

6. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

Music and Planned Program Content must be submitted via Sportity **no later than Friday, 6 March 2026**.



Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s), ISU Member. Music files must be in MP3 format. CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee. Each Competitor must have his/her own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program.

7. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

All Referees, the Technical Panel (Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators) Judges, Competitors, Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but no later than **Friday, 6th March, 2026** the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival or any other information concerning transportation and arrivals.

The nearest airport is Riga International Airport (RIX) with a distance of 14 km to the venue. Please be aware that the Organizing Committee does not provide any transportation from the Airport for the participating teams.

8. OFFICIAL HOTELS

Information regarding official hotels and accommodation options will be available in the Sportity application.

9. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2025, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

10. DRAWS

Draws will be conducted electronically.

Draws schedule will be published after final entry.

The starting order for the Free Skating will be in reverse order of the Short Program results.

11. TIMETABLE

A detailed time schedule will be available in the **Sportity** application soon after the close of entries.

12. ONLINE BROADCAST

Daugava Open Cup 2026 will be fully broadcast live.

13. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES

The three best placed Skaters/Pairs in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists.

All skaters will receive small gifts!

14. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in Daugava Open Cup 2026 to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. The Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.



15. THE CODE OF ETHICS

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2641 (or any update of this Communication). Violation of this rule will result in the disqualification of the skater.

16. GDPR

By entering all participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, sex.
