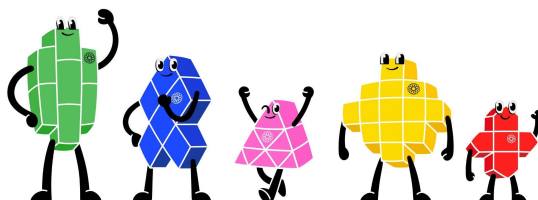

ANNOUNCEMENT



1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The SEA Games 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2025, as well as the current ISU Rules and Regulations and ISU Communications valid for the Season 2025/2026.

Participation in SEA Games 2025 is eligible for those Competitors who belong to **SEAGF member NOCs** who are also an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Competitors must be entered through their respective NOCs and Member Federations.

- **One (1) women's event**

COMPETITION FORMAT

To ensure an adequate number of competitors required by the SEA Games Federation, an open category will be used for this competition to allow skaters from 15 years old participate in the competition.

“Open category” in this competition consists of

1. Senior (age 17 and above) and
2. Junior (age 15-19).

Skaters will compete according to their respective age categories and will be judged within their own category—Senior or Junior—based on the ISU Technical Rules. However, for the purpose of final results, all skaters will be combined into a single **Open Category**. The overall ranking will be determined by the total scores of each skater, regardless of category.

Senior Men

Short Program:	The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2.
Duration:	2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec
Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
Duration:	4 min., +/-10 sec.

Senior Women

- Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2.
- Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec.
- Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
- Duration: 4 min., +/-10 sec.

Junior Men

- Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2025/2026.
- Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec
- Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.
- Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec

Junior Women

- Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 611, Paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2025/2026
- Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication.
Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec

STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials.

Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee.

The official announcement of the entries and of the panels of Officials is made by the Referee of each competition at the time of the first starting order draw of that competition.

The draws will take place on December 11, 2025. The schedule will be published after final entry.

STARTING ORDER FREE SKATING

In all categories in Free Skating, the starting order will be reversed to the results after the Short Program.

Draws will be published on the same day at www.fsatresults.com

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1. Entries for competitors and team officials must be made through their respective NOCs through the designated platform provided by The 33rd SEA Games Thailand 2025 Organizing Committee (THASOC).
- 3.2. Each NOC may enter a maximum of four (4) athletes including two (2) male athletes and two (2) female athletes in the figure skating competition.
- 3.3. Each NOC may enter a maximum of two (2) athletes per event.
- 3.4. Athletes must be 15 years of age and over (before 1 July 2025).
- 3.5. Skaters will be entered into their respective age categories—Junior or Senior—in accordance with ISU Rule 108.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

- Entry Form by Sport: Deadline 2 May 2025 at 24.00 (Bangkok time)
- Entry Form by Number: Deadline 8 May 2025 at 24.00 (Bangkok time)
- Entry Form by Name: Deadline 1 September 2025 at 24.00 (Bangkok time)
- All Entry Form by Sport, Entry Form by Number and Entry by Name may be sent via Game Management System (GMS) and subsequently confirmed with stamped original, then uploaded to the system.

4. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

Accredited participants and officials will be provided with full board accommodation beginning dinner Wednesday, December 10, 2025, until breakfast on Sunday, December 14, 2025.

The **travel expenses** will be covered for invited officials. Travel expenses for team members should be covered by their respective NOCs.

5. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by sending separately the music file to musicfsat@hotmail.com until December 4, 2025 (one week before the event). Any other format is not acceptable.

The title of the file must show the Nation, Competition event, Competitor's name, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.

Example: THA_Women_SP_Surname-Name_2:48

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file. CDs will not be accepted. During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and competitors will be allowed to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format_MP3_file).

The titles, composers, and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must be listed for each Competitor on the dedicated ISU platform.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. Dedicated ISU platform will be - portal.isu.swisstiming.com

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

6. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

The nearest airport to Bangkok, Thailand, is the Suvarnabhumi Airport (Bangkok) with a distance of approximately 30 km to the competition venue. The Organizing Committee will provide ground transportation services for all participants.

7. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be in accordance with the Games protocol. The accreditation information will be communicated to each participating NOC directly.

8. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2025 Thailand Open Figure Skating Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue of who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.

9. PROGRAM SCHEDULE

12 Dec 2025	- Official Practice - Competition Women (Free Skating) - Competition Men (Free Skating) - Awarding Ceremony - Round table discussion (Judges & TP)

10. RESULTS AND PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used. Results will be available at www.fsatresults.com

The overall ranking will be determined by the total scores of each skater, regardless of category. Medals will be awarded to the top three skaters in the Open Category.

All medalists must wear their respective NOC official uniform.
