1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Lombardia Trophy 2025 – International Competition for Pairs** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, as well as the current ISU Rules and Regulations and ISU Communications valid for the Season 2025/2026.

Participation in the **Lombardia Trophy 2025 - International Competition for Pairs** is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication. In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526: a Clearance Certificate is required for Skaters in the following circumstances:

1. any Skater who is not a citizen of the ISU Member's country, whom the ISU Member intends to enter in ISU Championships, other ISU Events and/or International Competitions in the coming season,
2. any Skater who is a citizen of the ISU Member's country and who has in the past represented another ISU Member in ISU Championships, other ISU Events and/or in International Competitions, whom the ISU Members intend to enter in ISU Championships, other ISU Events and/or International Competitions in the coming season.

Competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

2. TECHNICAL DATA

PLACE **Main and Practice Arena: ICE LAB ARENA Via San Bernardino 141 Bergamo BG**
(an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)

PAIRS Short Program The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 2 for 2025/2026.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec

Free Skating In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 4 min., +/-10 sec.

3 ENTRIES

3.1 General

All Entries must be made by the ISU Member concerned based on the regulations for Figure Skating 2025/26.

All entries for the **LOMBARDIA TROPHY– International Competition for Pairs** must be done through the **ISU Online Registration System (ORS)** by the deadline indicated. I.

3.2.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate one judge who has at least the qualification “Judge for International Competitions”.

In case of too many nominated judges, the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) not later than: **Friday August 15, 2025 – 20:00 h local time Bergamo**

Each panel of Judges will consist of at least 7 Judges. In exceptional cases and if there is no possibility to compose a panel of judges with at least 7 Judges, the ISU Vice-President Figure Skating may exceptionally authorize the panel in question to have a minimum of 6 Judges.

In case that at the time of the competition more Judges will be available and entered as required to compose the panels of Judges in one or more disciplines, the Organizing Member in consultation with the ISU will conduct on site, a draw for the panel of judges in the discipline in question for the first segment. The Judges, not drawn for the first segment will be seated for the second segment

The panel for the second segment (Free Skating) will in this case be completed by an open draw amongst the Judges serving in the first segment of the discipline in question.

3.2.3 Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches and the partner or relative of a Judge will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one Coach per Pairs will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Only two Team Officials of each Member, including the Member President provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation, will be accredited. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation. An accompanying person to a Judge will only be accepted for accreditation if this person is a partner in life or a relative of the Judge. The Member Federations guarantee that the requested accreditation of Team Members will correspond to their function within the team and the Federation. The names of all team members must be submitted via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) and must reach the Organizing Committee and the ISU Secretariat not later than **Friday August 15, 2025 – 20:00 h local time Bergamo**.

3.3 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

4. APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIAL

This Challenger Series in Figure Skating event will follow the requirements of the General Announcement for the Challenger Series in Figure Skating 2025/26 as well as ISU Communication 2683 and principles of Rule 420, paragraph 5.a) of the ISU Special Regulations Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 for appointing the Event Officials.

The members of each individual Technical Panel (Technical Controller and the Technical Specialists) will not be from the same ISU Member. At least two Technical Panel members will have the qualification "ISU", however one of the three members may have the qualification "International".

The Referee will have at least the qualification "International" and could be of the same ISU Member as one member of the Technical Panel (Technical Controller and Technical Specialists).

The Data Operator and the Replay Operator will have at least the qualification "International".

5. MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists beginning with dinner on **Friday 12th of September** until breakfast on **Monday 15th of September** and for Data and Replay Operators and Judges participating, beginning with lunch on **Friday 12th of September** until breakfast on **Monday 15th of September**.

Should any of the above-mentioned people arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists, the Data and Replay Operators.

6. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD in any other approved format, in accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2. A list of titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single and Pairs, for the Short and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must be entered on the ISU Portal. Members can download the entered information to send to the Organizing Committee.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2, all covers/discs must show the Competition event, Competitor's name, the Nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate disc. In addition competitors/couples must provide a back-up drive for each program.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

7. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

9. ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the **ICE RINK** starting from Thursday, September 11th at 13:00.

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per participating team, one Coach per Pair, a maximum of two Team Officials of ISU Members (including the Member President), provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head

Office of their Federation and a maximum of two medical persons. Accreditation will only be granted to people in those various functions, if officially entered and named through their ISU Member.

The ISU Member certifies with the signed entry form the indicated functions within the team of all team members. Any misuse of any function will be sanctioned by the ISU/OC.

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests.

Chaperons will not receive accreditation

10. DRAW

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held on Friday, September 12, 2025. The exact place and time will be published in the official detailed schedule.

Starting order for the free skating will be in reverse order of the results of the short program.

11. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

12. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES

The three best placed Couples will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists. The national anthem of the winner will be played and the flags of the medal winners hoisted.

13. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The ISU assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

14. EXHIBITION

No Exhibitions are in program.

15. MEETINGS FOR ISU EVENT OFFICIALS AND JUDGES

All Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and Judges are responsible to make their travel arrangements in order to be able to attend the respective event related meetings. If any other party makes the flight arrangements, the Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and the Judges are responsible to check if such arrangements are in line with the detailed schedule as mentioned under paragraph 18.
