

SKATE FEHERVAR 2025 is an integral part of the European Criterium Trophy competitions (http://www.europeancriterium.eu).

GENERAL:

The SKATE FEHERVAR 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 as well as pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the SKATE FEHERVAR 2025 is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of it.

TECHNICAL DATA

Place of the competition

Main arena: Székesfehérvár, MET Aréna, Rozmaring utca 14.

The rink is indoor. The size of the ice surface is 60 m x 26 m.

ENTRIES

Competitors Junior and Senior categories (International competition) must be entered through their ISU Members. If there are too many entries registered in an individual category and the competition cannot be held according to the published preliminary schedule, the organizer may limit the number of competitors in the free skating up to 30 for Juniors and Seniors.

Competitors taking part in International competition must be registered through their respective ISU Member Federations on the ISU ORS registration system. (https://fskors.isu.swisstiming.com)

The number of registered competitors is not limited. After the ISU Member receives confirmation of the entries from the ORS system, then they login a maximum of two competitors per category on the European Criterium entry system with music, or/and they forward the received confirmations from the ORS to their interested clubs, who can then login a maximum of two competitors per category with music on the European Criterium entry system.

Each participant must send to web administrator (http://www.europeancriterium.eu) request for code direct online registration and realize the entry not later (deadline for entries) than 16th November 2025. The entries for the competition will be held via web portal europeancriterimu.eu. Before entry procedure association/club representative need to apply for new account on www.europeancriterium.eu/ Account/Register.

Organizer reserves the right to make exceptions and to accept additional entries. Each competitor registrant must confirm that the competitor has been confirmed through the ORS system.

Organizers of the European Criterium website are committed to the proper protection of personal data in accordance with the European Union GDPR Regulation. Therefore, in the context of Privacy Policy, is require appropriate consent in the applications. Without this, the entries for European Criterium competitions can not possible in the future.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated_ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team_in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

MUSIC

After confirming and sending new registration data of selected competitors it is mandatory to add files with music the competitors need for their performances.

The process anticipates that competitor's application is in the pending status first. After confirming there is an option to attach the appropriate music file to competitor's application.

When the file is attached to application the status of competitor's application goes to active status and the competitor is included in the official competitors list of selected competition.

Mandatory music format is .mp3 file format.

Applicants (representative of club or national skating association) is given the option to replace the files with music three day before the competition starts.

Junior and Senior Categories have to attach two music files for valid active status of competitor's application (Short program and Free Skating program).

Organizers of competitions can download a music file of selected competitor and download a full package of files ordered and grouped by the categories.

Competitors must have copy of their mp3 files on USB key (or any external USB drive).

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

All entries (for both competitions) - competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches, other participants are expected not later than **November 16th 2025**.

ENTRY FEE FOR COMPETITION

Junior, Senior: 100 EUR

The entry fee must be paid for each competitor at latest during Registration before the competition.

*In case of bank transfer all charges are taken by the payer.

In case of cancellation, the participant must notify the organizer by e-mail latest until 20th November. After the deadline the entry fee will not be refunded or will be claimed in case of withdrawals for any reason.

Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure:

In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

The local organizing committee has the right and obligation to check the personal identification documents of the athletes to determine whether they are allowed to compete, whether they are competing in the right category, etc. Without the documents, the athlete will be excluded from the competition.

CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS

All results will be calculated in the new ISU Judging System.

DRAW

Draw for Junior and Senior categories will be performed in the presence of the Referee and Technical Controler in accordance with Rules 512 and 513 at 14:00 hour, Friday 5th December 2025. Starting order for the free skating of categories Juniors and Seniors will be in reverse order of the results of the short program.

JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Panel of Judges and Technical Panel will be formed by the organizing committee and will include judges from the participating countries on the Competition. Panel of Judges for Novice, Junior and Senior will composed as determined by the relevant ISU Communications.

EXPENSES

Organizer covers the accommodation expenses with full board only for the confirmed Referees, Judges, nominated Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators in the Hotel Platán (Székesfehérvár, Gyümölcs utca 28.), from dinner on December 3th until breakfast on December 7th. Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Club via E-mail. The transport from the hotel to the ice rink and back will be provided. Expenses for accommodation and meals for Competitors and other Team officials will not be covered by the organizer.

SCORING SYSTEM FOR INDIVIDUAL CATEGORIES

After each Competition, points will be awarded to the competitors group JUNIORS based on their ranking; minimum three competitions and more than half of the competitions held in the season can counted for the final ranking for each skater, the best three results their achieved.

The final results of the European Criterium series will be announced after the last event. In case of a tie between two or more athletes, the skater who had better places on the competitions will be higher on the final ranking.

Total scoring for individual competitors applies to those declared by different applicants in one trophy season only until the first change (clubs, associations, federations ...), as already the case for joint scoring for clubs / federations.

Points for the final ranking on the competition will be awarded as followed:

1st place, 15 points

2nd place, 12 points

3rd place, 10 points

4th place, 9 points

5th place, 8 points

6th place, 7 points

7th place, 6 points

8th place, 5 points

9th place, 4 points

10th place, 3 points

11th place, 2 points

all other athletes receive 1 point

SCORING SYSTEM FOR PARTICIPANTS

The final ranking of participants (club, skating federation or skating association) will be calculated from the points of their skaters on the ranking. Only two skaters results per a category can be counted of each participant. In final ranking can be counted only the three best results for each participant.

In case of tie between two or more participants the one that attended on more competitions will be higher on the final ranking. If there is still a tie then the participant which had skaters in more categories will be higher at the end.

AWARDING

The Organizing Committee for each contest will provide the awards as follows:

1st place medals, cup or diplomas,

2nd place medals, cup or diplomas,

3rd place medals, cup or diplomas. Diplomas for all athletes.

The three best placed Skaters/Couples in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists.

FINAL AWARDING

At the last event of the European Criterium series the individual winners of the final ranking of each category and the best participants will get a trophy. At least three complete competitions in one season are required to award trophies.

LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Regulations, Rule 119, all participants act on their own responsibility. Organizer will provide medical emergency aid during competition.

The ISU and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred by Competitors and Officials.

ORGANIZING COMMITTEE

The Office of the Organizing Committee will be located on the ice-rink and will be on disposal from Thursday, December 4th to Sunday, December 7th during the whole event.

ACCOMODATION

All participants except members of Technical Panel and Panel of Judges must cover their accommodation expenses by themselves.
