INTERNATIONAL SOLO ICE DANCE COMPETITION  
09 - 11 APRIL EGNA/NEUMARKT, ITALY



## 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The **Solo Dance Symphony Egna 2026** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU International Solo Ice Dance Competition Guidelines 2025/26, General Rules and Requirements, and the International Solo Ice Dance Competition Guidelines 2025/26 Technical Rules and Level Requirements.

Skaters must provide a passport or other proof of age to verify skaters meet age requirements as outlined in the International Solo Ice Dance Competition Guidelines 2025/26.

All participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, sex.

#### ENTRY FEE

**Entry Fee for skater € 100,00**

In the case that no judge has been entered by the respective Member Federation the **entry fee for a skater raises the amount to € 180,00.**

Late entries are subject to an additional €50 late fee and are not guaranteed acceptance.

For all nominated Referees, members of the Technical Panel (Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators), and Judges participating in the Competition, the Organizer will provide accommodation and meals from dinner on Wednesday, April 8, 2026, through breakfast on Sunday, April 12, 2026.

Should any of the above-mentioned persons arrive at the hotel before or stay beyond the period described above, any additional room costs and related expenses shall be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid directly upon arrival.

All Referees, members of the Technical Panel (Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators), and Judges taking part in the Competition are requested to inform the Organizing Committee of their flight/train numbers, dates, and times of arrival and departure, or any other relevant transportation details, as soon as possible and no later than March 28, 2026, in order to arrange check-ins and check-outs.

The hotel is located 1.5 km from the ice rink.

**The Organizing Committee will not cover or arrange travel expenses for Judges to and from Egna, nor transfers between the Officials' Hotel and the airport. These expenses shall be borne by the respective Member Federations. This does not apply to Referees and members of the Technical Panel, whose travel expenses will be covered by the Organizer.**

## 5. TRANSPORTATION

The nearest airport is Verona Valerio Catullo International Airport (132Km).

The nearest train stations are Egna train station (2,6Km) and Bolzano train station (25Km).

The Organizing Committee does not provide any transportation to the participants.

## 6. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will be at the Ice Rink. All the Skaters are requested to present a valid passport as per ISU rules at the time of registration. In accordance with the ISU Directive please note that at the time of registration (Entry fee, music) we must copy and file the passport of the Skaters.

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors and one Team Leader per ISU Member, one Coach per skater, a maximum of two Team Officials of ISU Members (including the Member President), provided that they are Council Members, Technical Committee Members or Members of the Head Office of their Federation and a maximum of two medical persons.

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests.

**Chaperones will not receive accreditation.**

## 7. DRAW

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held on April 8th, 2026. The exact place and time will be published in the official detailed schedule. Starting order for the Free Dance will be in reverse order of the results of the Pattern Dances or Rhythm Dance.

## 8. UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE

Unofficial practice time will be made available at extra cost in the late afternoon of Tuesday, April 7, and on Wednesday, April 8. Should an athlete become interested, we advise you to contact the OC as soon as possible to ensure your slot.

## 9. MUSIC/PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

Music and **COMPLETE MUSIC INFORMATION** must be sent by e-mail to [music.egna@gmail.com](mailto:music.egna@gmail.com). PPC sheets must be sent by e-mail to [music.egna@gmail.com](mailto:music.egna@gmail.com).

All files must show the competitor's name, the nation and the exact running time of the music. Each program (Pattern Dance, Rhythm Dance, Free Dance) must be saved in a separate file and should be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the names of the competitors.

Example: SUI\_ID\_FD\_MUSTERMANN-Erika\_MUSTERMANN-Max

Responsibility for submitting the competitor's music rests with the ISU Member, the competitor, the competitor's club, or the coach. The music must be sent as a direct email attachment to the Organizing Committee ([music.egna@gmail.com](mailto:music.egna@gmail.com)) by Wednesday, April 1, 2026 (one week prior to the competition). Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

The music files must be sent as MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a MP3 file (CD will not be accepted by the OC).

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

## 10. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

The three best placed Dancers in each event will be announced and honored. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time.

## 11. EXHIBITION

No Exhibition Gala is scheduled to take place.

## 12. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Solo Dance Symphony 2026 to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

## 13. MEETINGS FOR ISU EVENT OFFICIALS AND JUDGES

All Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and Judges are responsible to make their travel arrangements in order to be able to attend the respective event related meetings.

If any other party makes the flight arrangements, the Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators and the Judges are responsible to check if such arrangements are in line with

the detailed schedule as mentioned under paragraph 15.
