2026 SOUTHEAST ASIA (SEA) OPEN FIGURE SKATING TROPHY

September 11 – 13, 2026 Manila, Philippines

1. WELCOME

The Philippine Skating Union and the Organizing Committee are glad to invite you to participate in the 2026 Southeast Asia (SEA) Open Figure Skating Trophy.

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The 2026 SEA Open Figure Skating Trophy in Single Skating will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution 2025, as well as Competition & Event Regulations 2026, Sorts Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, and relevant ISU Communications. The new regulations amended at the ISU Congress in June 2026 will apply to this competition.

Participation in the competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 8.1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 7, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 9.3. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 8.2 and ISU Communication 2526. Passports of the skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

Competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials.

Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee.

The official announcement of the entries and of the panels of Officials is made by the Referee of each competition at the time of the first starting order draw of that competition.

STARTING ORDER FREE SKATING

For Free Skating there will be no draws. The reverse order of places in the Short Program will be used for the free skating starting order.

4. ENTRIES

4.1. Entries of Competitors

ISU Members must enter their competitors and their substitutes via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS)

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation/Association.

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants to three (3) entries in each category per ISU Member.

After closing of entries if additional places are available, those members who requested additional places will be contacted.

Entries by names must be sent not later than **MONDAY, AUGUST 10, 2026, 11:59PM (local time Manila)**

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4.2. Entries of Team Officials

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff, Coaches and Chaperones must be made via the ORS. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one (1) Coach and one (1) Chaperone per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

5. ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

- USD 120 – Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice
- USD 150 – Advanced Novice, Junior & Senior

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

After the final entry of **MONDAY, AUGUST 10, 2026, 11:59PM (local time Manila)** respective Member Federation will receive an email for Entry fee. Entry fee must be paid within 5 business days after receiving invoices. After 5 business days nonpaid entries will be automatically deleted.

Any late payments after the deadline will incur a USD 30 late payment fee.

6. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the: Referees, Judges (drawn), Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators beginning with **lunch/dinner WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2026, until breakfast on MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2026.**

The **travel expenses (flight and airport transfers)** will be covered only for Invited Referees, Technical Controller, Technical Specialist and Data and Replay Operators.

The organizer will not be able to cover any expenses for competitors and team officials.

7. MUSIC/PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by sending the file(s) to music.phsu@gmail.com until August 27, 2026 (two weeks before the event). Any other format is not accepted.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1, the title of the file must show the Competition event, Competitor's

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name, the Nation, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate USB stick.

Example: JuniorWomen_SP_Surname-Name_PHI_2:48

The titles, composers, and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must be listed for each Competitor on the dedicated ISU platform.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. Dedicated ISU platform will be - <https://portal.isu.swisstiming.com/>

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

With the entry forms, the “Program Content Sheet” must be returned to the Organizing Committee in time via the ORS. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

8. OFFICIAL HOTEL

9. AIRPORT PICKUP SERVICE

The nearest airport to Manila, Philippines, is the Ninoy Aquino International Airport with a distance of approximately 7 km to the official hotel. The Organizing Committee will provide ground transportation services for all Referees, the Technical Panel (Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators) and Judges.

Participating teams are to take care of their own travel from airport to the hotel. Below are the rates available for airport transfer by Lanson Place Mall of Asia. Taxi services are also available at the airport.

- Car PHP 3,000 per car (up to 3 persons with luggage)
- Van PHP 4,300 per coaster (up to 10 persons with luggage)

11. PDPA

By entering all participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition. Personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, gender.

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12.INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Article 17.3 of the Competition & Event Regulations, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2024 SEA Open Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.

The three best placed Skaters in each event will be announced and honored. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists. All participants will receive a certificate with their placement. The exact time of the Award Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please make sure that all skaters are represented at the Ceremony.
