1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The 2026 Asian Open Figure Skating Trophy will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution 2025, the ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, and the relevant ISU Communications, including but not limited to ISU Communications 2526, 2786, 2788 and any subsequent updates or replacements. **The new regulations amended at the ISU Congress in June 2026 will apply to this competition.**

Participation in the 2026 Asian Open Figure Skating Trophy is open to Skaters belonging to an ISU Member, in accordance with the ISU Competition & Event Regulations Article 8 Residence & Citizenship, provided they meet the eligibility requirements of Article 7.2, the age requirements of Article 9, and the participation, citizenship and residency requirements set forth in Article 8.1 through 8.5, and ISU Communication 2526 or any update thereof.

In accordance with Article 8 of the ISU Competition & Event Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 (or any update thereof), all Skaters who do not possess the nationality of the Member by which they are entered, or who have previously represented another Member, must submit an ISU Clearance Certificate. All entries must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the respective ISU Member Federation. The competition will be judged in accordance with the ISU Judging System applicable for the 2026/27 season.

2. COMPETITION VENUE

Venue: Oasis Centre Arena (OCA) Ice Rink

Please note:

All requirements are based on the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, and the relevant ISU Communications in force at the time of publication. These requirements are subject to change in accordance with any subsequent ISU Rules, Communications, or amendments adopted by the ISU Congress or ISU Council, including those that may come into effect after the ISU Congress 2026.

4. STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials. Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee. Draw schedule for: Novices, Juniors, Seniors - will be published after final entry.

5. ENTRIES

A. Entries of Competitors

ISU Members must enter their competitors and their substitutes via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS): <https://fsk-ors.isu.swisstiming.com/>

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation/Association. Entries by names must be made through electronic registration system. In case of any problems with the registration procedure, you can contact: E-mail: info@iceskatingindonesia.com

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants to three (3) entries in each category per ISU Member. After close of entries if additional places are available, those members who requested additional places will be contacted. Entries by names must be sent not later than **Wednesday, July 1st, 2026, at 1800 Hours (GMT+7) – Jakarta time.**

B. Entries of Judges

Each participating Federation should nominate one judge with the qualification “Judge for International competitions” or “ISU Judge” The nominated judges must be on the current ISU list of Officials (ISU Communication No. 2735). The organizer decides on the composition of the panel of judges. In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges after the

closing date for the entries. The written confirmation will be sent to each federation immediately. The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the respective Member Federation/Association not later than **Wednesday, July 1st, 2026, at 1800 Hours (GMT+7) – Jakarta time.**

C. Entries of Team Officials

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff, Coaches and Chaperones must be made through the link provided after the entry closed. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer. Please be advised that only one (1) Coach per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

6. ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

- USD 250 - Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice
- USD 300 - Advanced Novice, Junior & Senior
- USD 350 - Pair

The entry fee is non-refundable in the event of withdrawal for any reason.

After the Final Entry deadline, Wednesday, 1 July 2026 at 18:00 (GMT+7), Jakarta time, the respective ISU Member Federations will receive an invoice for the entry fee(s).

The entry fee(s) shall be paid within five (5) days after receipt of the invoice. Entries for which payment has not been received within this period shall be automatically cancelled.

In any case, all entry fee(s) must be paid no later than **Wednesday, 8 July 2026 at 18:00 (GMT+7), Jakarta time**, by bank transfer to the following account:

Any late payments after the deadline will incur a USD 150 late payment fee.

7. MEALS, LODGING & TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the: Referees, Judges (drawn), Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators. The travel expenses will be covered only for Invited Referees, Technical Controller, Technical Specialist and Data and Replay Operators. The organizer will not be able to cover any expenses for competitors and team officials.

8. MUSIC & PLANED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by uploading the music file to <https://bit.ly/music2026AOFST> until **Friday, 24 July 2026**.
Any other format is not acceptable.
- The title of the file must show the Nation, Competition event, Competitor's name, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.
Example: INA_Men_SP_Bertrand-Russel_2:48
- Each Competitor must have an own back-up music (Phone or USB Stick) for each program in the format of MP3 file. CDs will not be accepted.
- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (Phone or USB Stick with file format_MP3_file).

The titles, composers, and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program / Rhythm Dance and Free Skating / Free Dance Program must be listed for each Competitor on the dedicated ISU platform. The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

11. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with the ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026 Article 17, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2026 Asian Open Figure Skating Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member’s team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or

property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.

12. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION (PDPA)

By entering the competition, all participants agree that their personal data will be collected by the **Organizing Committee (OC)** and stored and processed by the OC and, where necessary, by third parties, **solely for the purposes of and to the extent necessary to facilitate participation in the competition.**

Personal data may include, but shall not be limited to, **full legal name as stated in national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, and gender.**

13. RESULTS

The ISU Judging System (IJS), as described in the ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026 and the relevant ISU Communications in force for the 2026/27 season, will be used.

14. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

The three (3) best placed skaters in each event will be announced and honoured. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medallists from all categories. The exact time of the Award Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please make sure that all skaters are represented well-dressed at the Awarding Ceremony.
