2026 SOUTHEAST ASIA (SEA) OPEN FIGURE SKATING TROPHY

INTERCLUB: September 10 Manila, Philippines

1. WELCOME

The Philippine Skating Union and the Organizing Committee are glad to invite you to participate in the 2026 Southeast Asia (SEA) Open Figure Skating Trophy.

2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The 2026 SEA Open Figure Skating Trophy in Single Skating will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2025, as well as the current ISU Rules and Regulations and ISU Communications valid for the Season 2026/2027. The new regulations amended at the ISU Congress in June 2026 will apply to this competition.

Participation in the competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 8.1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 7, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 9.3. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 8.2 and ISU Communication 2526. Passports of the skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

Competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

3. TECHNICAL DATA

Place of competition: SM Mall of Asia Ice Skating Rink

Level 3 Main Mall, SM Mall of Asia, Seaside Blvd., Pasay City, Philippines
(an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 60x30m, air-conditioned)

INTERCLUB FIGURE SKATING COMPETITIONS:

Advanced Pre-Novice (boys & girls): has reached the age of 7 and has not reached 11 (Born between July 1, 2015 and June 30, 2019)

Basic Pre-Novice (boys & girls): has reached the age of 7 and has not reached 11 (Born between July 1, 2015 and June 30, 2019)

Advanced Juvenile (boys & girls): has not reached age of 8 (Born on or after 1 July, 2018)

Basic Juvenile (boys & girls): has not reached age of 8 (Born on or after 1 July, 2018)

ADVANCED PRE NOVICE (INTERCLUB COMPETITION)

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BOYS & GIRLS	<u>Free Skating</u>	1. Maximum of four (4) jump elements. One of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one jump combination and one jump sequence. A jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence, the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel Jump. No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed. Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once. Triple and quadruple jumps are not permitted. 2. 2.) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a combination spin, and one must be a spin in one position. All spins with change of foot must contain a minimum of eight (8) revolutions or without change of foot must contain a minimum of six (6) revolutions. Combination spin with 3 basic positions will receive full value. If this requirement is not fulfilled, the spin will be marked with a V. In both spins, flying entries are allowed. 3. 3.) There must be a maximum of one (1) choreographic sequence consisting of at least two (2) different skating movements. Levels: in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel. The following Program Components are judged: - Composition - Presentation - Skating Skills The factor for the Program Components is Boys: 1.67 Girls: 1.67 <u>Music Duration: 1:50 +/- 10 seconds</u>
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BASIC PRE NOVICE (INTERCLUB COMPETITION)

BOYS & GIRLS	<u>Free Skating</u>	1. Maximum of three (3) jump elements. There may be up to one (1) jump combination or sequence. The jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence, the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump. Only one jump can be repeated once in both solo and combination jumps. Triple and quadruple jumps are not permitted. 2. There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation). One of which must be an upright spin on one foot. All the spins without change of foot must have five (5) revolutions, with change of foot, three (3) revolutions on each foot. Flying entry is not allowed. Combination spin with 3 basic positions will receive full value, and all spins with change of foot must have at least 3 revolutions on each foot. If these requirements are not fulfilled, the spin will be marked with a V. 3. There must be a maximum one (1) choreographic sequence consisting of at least one (1) skating movement. One must be a backward spiral hold at least for three (3) seconds. If this requirement is not fulfilled,
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		the element will receive no value. Levels: in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel. The following Program Components are judged: - Composition - Presentation - Skating Skills The factor for the Program Components is Boys: 1.67 Girls: 1.67 Music Duration: 1:30 +/- 10 seconds
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ADVANCED JUVENILE (INTERCLUB COMPETITION)

BOYS & GIRLS	<u>Free Skating</u>	1. Maximum of three (3) jump elements. There may be up to one (1) jump combination or sequence. A jump combination can contain only two (2) single jumps. In the jump sequence, the second jump must be a single Axel jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the Axel jump. Only one single jump can be repeated once in both solo and combination jumps. Double, Triple and quadruple jumps are not permitted. 2. 2.) Maximum of two (2) spins. Spins without change of foot must have at least 4 revolutions, with change of foot must have at least 3 revolutions on each foot. In both spins, flying entry is not allowed. Combination spin with 3 basic positions will receive full value, and all spins with change of foot must have at least 3 revolutions on each foot. If these requirements are not fulfilled, the spin will be marked with a V. 3. 3.) There must be a maximum one (1) choreographic sequence consisting of at least one (1) skating movement. One must be a forward spiral held for a minimum of three (3) seconds. If this requirement is not fulfilled, the element will receive no value. Levels: in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel. The following Program Components are judged: - Composition - Presentation - Skating Skills The factor for the Program Components is Boys: 1.67 Girls: 1.67 Music Duration: 1:20 +/- 10 seconds
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BASIC JUVENILE (INTERCLUB COMPETITION)

BOYS & GIRLS	<u>Free Skating</u>	1. Maximum of three 3 jump elements, one of which must be a Waltz Jump. There may be up to one (1) jump combination or sequence. A jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence, the second jump must be a Waltz Jump or a Single Axel jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump into the take-off curve of the second jump. Only one jump can be repeated
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		once in both solo and combination jumps. Double, Triple and quadruple jumps are not permitted. 2. Maximum of two (2) spins, one of which must be an upright spin on two feet (minimum of 3 revolutions). Another spin can be spin in one position (different abbreviation) or combination spin without change of foot (minimum of 4 revolutions), two basic positions in a combo spin is allowed. In both spins, flying entry is not allowed. Combination spin with 3 basic positions will receive full value. If this requirement is not fulfilled, the spin will be marked with a V. 3. There must be a maximum one (1) choreographic sequence consisting of at least one skating movement. One must be a forward lunge held for a minimum of three (3) seconds. If this requirement is not fulfilled, the element will receive no value. Levels: in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to level 1 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel. The following Program Components are judged: - Composition - Presentation - Skating Skills The factor for the Program Components is Boys: 1.67 Girls: 1.67 Music Duration: 1:00 +/- 10 seconds
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Deduction for Pre-novice and Juvenile

a) Interruption

For every Interruption of:

- more than 10 seconds up to 20 seconds: -0.25
- more than 20 seconds up to 30 seconds: -0.50
- more than 30 seconds up to 40 seconds: -0.75

Interruption of the program with allowance of up to three (3) minutes to resume from the point of interruption: -1.5 per program

b) Other deductions: -0.25

- Program time violation up to every 5 seconds lacking or in excess
- Part of the costume/decoration falls on the ice
- Costume/prop violation
- Late start
- Falls
- per fall outside elements
- falls in elements will be called by the Technical Panel but with **no deduction(s)**.

STARTING ORDER - DRAW

Rule 512 Draws

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The draws for the starting order of all Segments are made publicly by the Referee. The Referee should ask the Organizing Committee to check the correct spelling of the names of the Competitors and Officials.

Starting numbers shall be drawn by each Competitor, if present, by official representatives of their ISU Member or by members of the Organizing Committee.

The official announcement of the entries and of the panels of Officials is made by the Referee of each competition at the time of the first starting order draw of that competition.

Draw schedule will be published after final entry

STARTING ORDER FREE SKATING

In all categories in Free Skating the starting order will be reversed to the results after the Short Program. Draws will be published on the same day at **phsureresults.org**

4. ENTRIES

4.1. Entries of Competitors

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation/Association. In case of any problems with the registration procedure, you can contact:

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants to three (3) entries in each category per ISU Member.

After closing of entries if additional places are available, those members who requested additional places will be contacted.

Entries by names must be sent not later than **MONDAY, AUGUST 10, 2026, 11:59PM (local time Manila)**

4.2. Entries of Team Officials

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff, Coaches and Chaperones must be made communicated by the member federation. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

Please be advised that only one (1) Coach and one (1) Chaperone per Skater will be accredited. An Assistant Team Leader will be accepted for Teams having six (6) and more Skaters. Not more than one (1) Team Doctor and one (1) Team Physiotherapist will be accepted as the Team Medical Staff, for which the organizer requests the right to have a medical certification (document) presented before accreditation.

5. ENTRY FEE

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

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- USD 120 – Advanced Juvenile, Basic Juvenile, Advanced Pre-Novice, Basic Pre-Novice

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

After the final entry of **MONDAY, AUGUST 10, 2026, 11:59PM (local time Manila)** respective Member Federation will receive an email for Entry fee. Entry fee must be paid within 5 business days after receiving invoices. After 5 business days nonpaid entries will be automatically deleted.

Any late payments after the deadline will incur a USD 30 late payment fee.

6. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the: Referees, Judges (drawn), Technical Controller, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators beginning with **lunch/dinner WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2026, until breakfast on MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2026.**

The **travel expenses (flight and airport transfers)** will be covered only for Invited Referees, Technical Controller, Technical Specialist and Data and Replay Operators.

The organizer will not be able to cover any expenses for competitors and team officials.

7. MUSIC/PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on mp3 format by sending the file(s) to music.phsu@gmail.com until August 27, 2026 (two weeks before the event). Any other format is not accepted. In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1, the title of the file must show the Competition event, Competitor's name, the Nation, and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate USB stick.

Example: BasicJuvenileGirls_FS_Surname-Name_PHI_1:10

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) through a form. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. The form shall be communicated to the respective federations after closure of entries.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee in time via the ORS. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

8. OFFICIAL HOTEL

9. AIRPORT PICKUP SERVICE

Personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, gender.

12.INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Article 17.3 of the Competition & Event Regulations, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2024 SEA Open Trophy, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.
