

ANNOUNCEMENT ALPE ADRIA TROPHY CELJE 2025 – FINAL & SLOVENIA OPEN 2025

Celje, 4th - 6th April, 2025



The Slovene Skating Union are honoured to invite your team to the Alpe Adria Trophy Celje 2025 – Final, which also applies to the National Championship 2025 in the Short Track Speed Skating.

Slovenia Skating Union have an honour to invite your team in Celje from 5th to 7th April 2024. The Alpe Adria Trophy Celje 2025 – Final (Slovenia Open Champinship 2025) is the short track speed skating competition is associated with the Alpe Adria Trophy Series competitions. The track is an indoor Ice Rink, with the measures of 60 x 30 m, with a standard track of 111.12 m. Padding will cover the boards in dangerous areas.

LOCATION

The competition will be carried out at the Celje indoor ice rink ("Mestni park", Partizanska 3a, Celje, Slovenia) on a track in accordance with Rule 280, Paragraphs 1 - 4. Protective padding will be used to cover the entire rink board in accordance with Rule 280, and the respective ISU Communications.

RULES

The All Final System would be applied. The first round of the first distance shall be made on the basis of the personal best time supplied with the Final Entry. Final Points will be awarded in the A and B Final races. The points 34, 21, 13, 8, 5, 3, 2, 1 are awarded in descending order commencing with first place. For the Final Classification the skaters are ranked:

- by total number of Final Points
- by combined ranking over all Distance Classification
- by the highest ranking achieved in one of the distances and subsequent other best rankings
- by best time over the longest distance on the program (See Rule 295)

Please note that the organizer reserves the right to modify competition system according to number of competitors and available time.


All skaters are allowed to race in their own age category, or one category older, however must compete in the same category in all Alpe Adria competitions of the season. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to combine age groups depending on the number of final entries per group. There is also a possibility of mixed gender groups for younger categories. Final results will be calculated for each age group separately.

DISTANCES

Seniors & Juniors A, B, C (Ladies, Men): 1500 m, 500 m, 1000 m, Juniors D (Girls, Boys): 1000 m, 500 m, 777 m, Juniors E (Girls, Boys): 777 m, 333 m, 500 m, Juniors F (Girls, Boys): 500 m, 222 m, 333 m, Juniors G (Girls, Boys): 333 m, 111 m, 222 m, Beginners (Girls and Boys together): Skill Races

SKILL RACES FOR BEGINNERS

Skill races will be organized on the first day of the competition, prior to the regular competition program. They are a fun way of stimulating skating enjoyment for the kids in more "game" oriented way on ice and a good opportunity for stimulating skating related activities wher kids have fun and develop themselves in a variety of ways, without the pressure of competing and yet within the exciting and inspiring environment of an international competition. The competition will be held only for Beginners group representatives. Competing in Skill Races cannot compete in distance events.



- Circuit race between obstacles, for 3 competitors, which ends after one lap,
- three competitors on the track,
- in the heat box, the trio prepared for the next three races.
- the length of the track is relative,
- estimated duration of the program max. 30 min,
- the final list will be known on the day of the competition
- Setting up an obstacle course,
- the help of four track stuarts,
- obstacles consist of mobile soft props, small tires, cushions, cones,
- track stewards monitor the condition of the track during the race and change the positions of obstacles according to instructions
- Presentation of the course/obstacles,
- address,
- demonstration race, three track stuarts.
- Takes the position of referee in the center
- New rule: in the event of a missed obstacle, the referee awards the competitor an additional 2s, at the final time.
- He forwards the decision to Competition Stuart, who records it
- the announcer announces over the sound system.
- Each race starts with the starting procedure, according to ISU rules.
- before the start, the announcer introduces the competitors on the track.
- Announcement of results
- after the skill races, for the three fastest, the Referee awarded medals and recognition with the official time (handwritten or printed).

RELAYS

Group A Men/Ladies - 3000m (Seniors, Juniors A and B) – teams of 4 skaters and Group B Boys /Girls - 2000m (Juniors C, D and E/F) – teams of 3 skaters. Gender-mixed teams are allowed in the Relay category- Junior C,D, E/F.

Relay competition will be conducted if at least 3 teams L/M are registered.

AWARDS

In each age category medals will be awarded to the best three skaters in the individual overall ranking and Beginners of the **Alpe Adria Trophy Celje 2025**.

In each age category, the best three skaters in the individual overall ranking of the season (min two competitions of the Alpe Adria Trophy series - Zagreb, Belgrade, Sarajevo and Celje) will receive the Alpe Adria Individual Trophy 2025.

The **Alpe Adria Team Trophy 2025** will be awarded to the team with the highest number of combined points from min two competitions of the Alpe Adria Trophy series. Points will be awarded to six highest ranked skaters in the Overall classification of each Alpe Adria Trophy competition in categories: Senior, Junior A, Junior B, Junior C, Junior D, Junior E, Junior F, Relay 3000m and 2000m. The highest ranked skaters will receive points in descending order: 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 and 1 point. However, only 2 best skaters from each participating club/member will receive Team Cup points. The points of subsequent skaters from the same club/member will go to the next placed skater of a different club/member. In case of a tie, the highest score in the Senior category (men and ladies) will decide the winner.

National Slovene Championships :

Only those Slovene Skaters will be recognized in the national overall classification, who took part in all three (3) announced distances. The award ceremony was also held for the best three individual competitors in the categories for the National Championship of Slovenia for the year 2025.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

There will be a Medical representative present at the warm up and during the competition.

EQUIPMENT

All equipment must be in line with the ISU rules (See Rule 2919. The use of compulsory safety equipment and proper rounding of the blades will be strictly monitored.

ACCOMMODATION

The expenses for accommodation and meals are at the sole responsibility of the participating teams. Please make the reservation yourself directly with the front desk of the hotel.

Entry fee: 40 EUR / skater.

It shoud be paid at the registration before the Team Leaders meeting in cash. A deposit of **50 EUR** per club will be charged for helmet covers and will be refunded at the end of competition upon return of all the helmet covers.

-Each competitor participates in the competition at his/her own risk and insurance,

-The Organizing Committee declines all responsibility for any loss or damage during the competition. The skaters are requested to cover their own health insurance.
