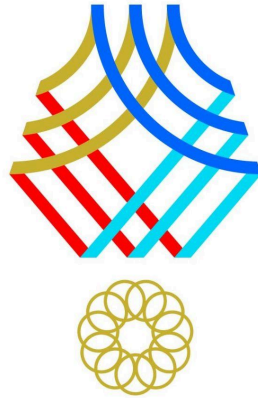

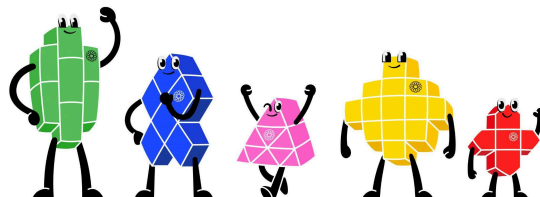

General Regulations

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the International Skating Union (ISU) Regulations 2024 and relevant Communications. Participation is open to SEAGF member NOCs who are also an ISU Member.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

Technical Data

All events as well as official practices will take place at the “IWIS International Training Center” (Address: 999/1 Sukhumvit Rd, Samrong Nua, Muang, Samutprakarn 10270 Thailand) with an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface 30x60 m. The compass of the track is 111.12 m, according to ISU Rules. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and the respective ISU Communications.

Competition Format

“Knock-Out System” with all the necessary qualification rounds will be applied to qualify skaters to a Final A & a Final B. Drawing and seeding procedures are in accordance with ISU rules 293. At the end of every distance, a final classification will be made following rule 297 paragraph 2.

To ensure a sufficient number of entries, skaters from Senior, Junior A and Junior B will be combined and ranked together.

False Start Policy

The false start policy for the event is as follows:

- Junior A, Junior B and Senior: Zero False Start

Events and Distances

The competitor's division is based on age as at 1st July 2025.

Entry

All Entry Form by Sport, Entry Form by Number and Entry by Name may be sent via Game Management System (GMS) and subsequently confirmed with stamped original, then uploaded to the system.

Separate entry forms including competitor's personal best time for all categories and distances must be sent by e-mail to the Figure & Speed Skating Association of Thailand at fsat@windowslive.com before **1 November 2025**.

A skater may enter only one category for the individual and two categories for the relay based on their birth date. Skaters in Senior, Junior A and Junior B will compete together under the same ranking system.

This schedule is subject to change depending on the numbers of final entry. The team leader meeting will be held at the Meeting Room at the competition venue.

Equipment

Skaters will be provided with a helmet cover and a transponder. A deposit of 100 USD/skater is required to be paid by cash upon registration. The deposit will be fully refunded when all equipment is returned at the end of the competition in a good condition. In case of any damage or loss, the deposit paid will not be refunded.

Skaters are required to use all safety equipment in accordance with Rule 288. Knee and shin pads, neck guards, bodysuits, safety helmet and gloves are compulsory equipment for all competitors and must be worn appropriately. There are no exceptions, else the skaters will not be allowed on the ice to race.

Blades used in the Short track events must be short track blades conforming to ISU regulations with tubes closed, and compulsory rounding of the corners of the blades with the blade ends rounded off with a minimum radius of 10mm.

Awards

Medals will be awarded to the top three competitors in the individual events and to each member of the winning relay teams. Please make sure that all skaters are present at the Ceremony. All medalists must wear their respective NOC official uniform.

Event Officials

The Organizing Committee will offer full-board accommodations for a Technical Delegate and Event Officials from 16-20 December 2025. Additionally, honorariums will be provided for the Technical Delegate and Event Officials from 17-19 December 2025.

Insurance and Liability

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, the Figure & Speed Skating Association of Thailand and the Organising Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Anti-doping

The 33rd SEA Games Thailand 2025 Organizing Committee, shall establish the SEAGF Anti-Doping Committee, which shall, under the guidance of the SEAGF and working with the SEAGF Office, be responsible for the Anti-Doping program for the 33rd SEA Games Thailand 2025. The Anti-Doping program will be run in accordance with the SEAGF Anti-Doping Rules and the WADA International Standard for Testing and Investigation. Sample analysis will be performed at a WADA-accredited laboratory or as otherwise approved by WADA. Both urine and blood tests will be conducted before and during the competition to ensure compliance.

Athletes requiring the use of a Prohibited Substance or Prohibited Method during the event must apply for a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) through the SEAGF Anti-Doping Committee by the specified deadline (TBC). If an athlete has already been granted a TUE by their National Anti-Doping Organization or International Federation, the SEAGF Anti-Doping Committee will recognize it.
