Quartet starts will be used in the 3000m (it may also be used for 1000 and 1500m) according to ISU Communication No. 2729, paragraph 5.1).

#### TRACK

A standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at Ritten Arena, an artificially frozen outdoor skating rink in Collalbo/Ritten. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 26 and 30 meters, respectively. The width of the inside training lane is 4 meters.

## ENTRIES

Entries for this competition will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2729, paragraph 4.

As per ISU Rule 108, participation in the **Juniors division** is open to:

- **Juniors A and B** born in the period 1 July 2006 – 30 June 2010

Participation in the **Neo-seniors division** is open to:

- **Skaters** born in the period 1 July 2002 – 30 June 2006

Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events on <https://ssk-entries.isu.org/> and respecting the following deadlines:

*Preliminary entries*, giving the estimated number of Competitors and the number of coaches and other team staff, as well as provisional names of the Competitors and Team leader must be communicated at the latest *by Friday, November 7, 2025*.

*Final entries* including the names of the Competitors and available substitutes, as well as the names of the Team leader, coaches and other team staff for whom an accreditation is required must reach the Organizing Committee at the latest by 12:00 noon (local time) on Monday, December 1, 2025

**Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 2731, need to be strictly observed.** For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communication No. 2731 or any update of this Communication.

**In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.**

## ENTRY QUOTAS

An ISU Member<sup>1</sup> may enter a maximum of 10 Competitors per category (10 Women and 10 Men). Subject to the qualifying times criteria listed below, maximum 4 Competitors for 500 and 1000m, maximum 3 Competitors for 1500 and 3000m and maximum 2 Competitors for Mass Start may be entered for each individual event in each Division (Juniors & Neo-seniors). For the Mixed Relay event, an ISU Member may enter maximum one team in each division. One (1) Junior Skater may take part in the Mixed Relay event in the Neo-senior Division but not vice versa.

<sup>1</sup> Reference is made to ISU Communication No. 2469, paragraph 2.a) according to which and until further notice, no individual

belonging to the Russian Skating Union and Skating Union of Belarus shall be invited, entered and allowed to participate in International Competitions, ISU Championships and other ISU Events.

### **QUALIFYING TIMES**

Entered Skaters (including substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances, as listed in ISU Communication No. 2729, paragraph 4.

### **MASS START RACES**

Mass Start races will be organized in accordance with Rule 243, paragraph 4, Rule 257 and Rule 265, paragraph 6.1 and 6.4 and ISU Communication No. 2729.

Based on rule 257 2.2 the SSTC can decide to organize the MS as an elimination race. The rules for an elimination race will be published in the Communication for Team discipline and Mass start races. Further information will be provided to Teams onsite.

### **MIXED RELAY RACES**

Mixed Relay races will be skated according to Rule 256, paragraph 3.1 and ISU Communication No. 2729, with national teams of 2 Skaters each (one Woman and one Man), and with distances of 6 laps in total, i.e. 3 laps for Women and 3 laps for Men.

### **GROUPING AND DRAWING PROCEDURES**

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be according to ISU Communication No. 2729, paragraph 6.

### **POINTS**

For each distance Junior World Cup points will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2729, paragraph 7.2.

### **PRIZES**

Prizes will be presented to the three (3) best Skaters in each event (distance) in each Division. Junior World Cup points gained will count towards the final ISU Junior World Cup ranking 2024/25.

### **ANTI-DOPING**

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

### **TRAINING TIMES**

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from Wednesday, December 3, 2025. Trial starts will be organized on Friday, December 5, 2025, at 3:00 PM

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

### **LIABILITY**

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, F/ISG and the Organizing

Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage incurred in connection with the ISU Junior World Cup Speed Skating. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.
