REGULATIONS

The ISU World Speed Skating Championships (Allround & Sprint combination) will be held in accordance with the 2024 Regulations of the International Skating Union (ISU) and relevant ISU Communications, in particular ISU Communication No. 2730.

Participation in the Championships is open to Skaters who belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 1) that has been allocated quota place(s) for the Championships, and who have met the qualification criteria according to Rule 208 and ISU Communication No. No. 2730.

TRACK

Thialf is an indoor artificially frozen ice rink with a standard track of 400 meters and inner and outer curves with radii of 26 and 30 meters respectively. The width of the inside training track is 4 meters. In accordance with Rue 228 a protective moveable padding system will be installed around the track.

TITLE AND AWARDS

The winners of the Championships are the Skaters with the lowest total of points after 4 distances have been completed (Rule 265, paragraph 2 and 268, paragraph 1).

The winners of the **Sprint Combination** will bear the title: "World Sprint Speed Skating Champion for 2026", and the winners of the **Allround Combination** will bear the title: "World Allround Speed Skating Champion for 2026" (Rule 133, paragraph a), and will each be awarded the ISU Championships "gold" medal. The Skaters placed second and third in the final classification of each combination after 4 distances will be awarded the ISU Championships "silver" and "bronze" medals, respectively.

Prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2516, or any further update of this Communication.

ENTRIES

The entry quotas will be determined partly by the results from the World Speed Skating Championships (Allround & Sprint combination) 2024 and partly by results achieved during the ISU World Cup Speed Skating Competitions #1 to #5 held during the season 2026/26, in accordance with Rule 208, paragraphs 2.2.1, 2.3.1 and ISU Communication No. 2730. The actual entry quotas will be published by the ISU and communicated to the ISU Members concerned in due time before the deadline for final entries.

According to ISU Communication No. 2730 and Rule 208, paragraph 2.3.1, the following ISU Members have been pre-allocated entry quotas for the **Sprint Combination**:

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication 2731 need to be strictly observed.

For more details please refer to Rules 115, 131, 208 and ISU Communications No. 2731.

CITIZENSHIP/RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS AND CLEARANCE PROCEDURE

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

DRAWING

The drawings will be made in accordance with Rules 239 and 240, paragraph 1 to 4. For the last distance of the Allround Combination (5000m Women and 10000m Men) the number of Skaters to qualify will be 8 (Rule 240, paragraph 3.a).

ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communication No. 2742 (or any further update of these Communications).

LIABILITY

In accordance with the ISU General Regulations (Rule 119), the ISU, KNSB and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with this Championship. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

DUTCH GAMBLING AUTHORITY

As of July 1, 2025, the Dutch Gambling Authority (Kansspelautoriteit) has implemented a ban on untargeted advertising by online gambling providers. This includes, but is not limited to:

- · Sponsorship of sports clubs and events
- Displaying logos on sportswear, banners, and other promotional materials
- General advertising campaigns not specifically targeted to verified adult audiences

The primary objective of this measure is to protect vulnerable groups, particularly young people, from the risks associated with gambling addiction. The Kansspelautoriteit is responsible for monitoring and enforcing compliance with these new regulations."

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from Monday March 2, 2026. Trial starts will be organized on Wednesday March 4, 2026.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

BOARD AND LODGING

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for expenses for board and lodging at the official hotel from lunch on Wednesday, March 4 until lunch on Monday, March 9, 2026 (Rule 137 paragraphs 10 and 14) for all Competitors participating in the Championships (not for the substitutes) and 1 Team leader or coach for each ISU Member. Expenses of other Skaters and officials (i.e. reserves, substitutes, coaches, other team staff members and accompanying persons) other than those mentioned above, and expenses before or after the period mentioned above, will be at their own expense.

Accommodation requests can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

OFFICIAL HOTELS

The Organizing Committee will arrange hotel reservation for all Skaters and officials at the

Cancellation policy:

- Travel dates, transportation and hotel request until 20 February 2026
- Cancellation policy and final adjustments 2 March 2026
- Cancellation after February 23, 2026, until 24h before arrival: 25% of reservation value
- Cancellation after March 3, 2026: 75% of reservation value
- Cancellation on day of arrival or no show: 100% charge

TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from Monday March 2, 2026, to Monday March 9, 2026 from and to the Schiphol Airport. Team officials who do not travel together with their team cannot be guaranteed this transportation service.

A shuttle bus service will be available between the official hotel and the ice-rink from Monday March 2, 2026, to Sunday March 8, 2026

The Organizing Committee must be informed via the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events about the date and time of arrival and departure of the competitors and officials as soon as possible, but at the latest by February 4, 2026.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

A visitor visa may be required for participants and team officials. Please contact the OC if you need an invitation letter for the visa. For the invitation letter please submit the following information:

- First Name
- Last Name
- Passport number
- Date of Birth

Please submit all this information to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, in order to have the necessary visas completed in due time.

To facilitate immigration procedures all Event participants (Skaters, Team staff, Officials) need to present a personal invitation letter for the Event on arrival in The Netherlands. Personal information as specified above for Visa application must therefore be submitted to the OC not later than December 1st, 2025.
