GENERAL RULES

Britannia Cup 2025 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating as well as relevant ISU Communications for Season 2024/2025.

All teams and competitors must belong to an ISU Member and qualify regarding eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in the ISU Rules and they must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in the ISU Rules & Communications in effect.

By entering this Competition, you confirm you are an eligible skater, and you agree to abide by the Competition Regulations, BIS Policies and this announcement.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS ISU- CATEGORIES

The following Categories are included:

Senior Combined: At least 17 years before July 1, 2024, 12 - 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

Short program 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less;

Free Skating program 4 minutes (+/- 10 sec);

Elements: ISU Comm. 2635

Junior: At least age of 13 but have not reached the age 19 before July 1, 2024, 12 - 16 skaters with a

maximum of 4 alternates.

Short program 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less;

Free Skating 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 sec);

Elements: ISU Communication 2635

Advanced Novice: At least age of 10 but have not reached the age 16 before July 1, 2024, 12 - 16 skaters with a

maximum of 4 alternates.

Free Skating 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec); Elements: ISU Communication 2635

ENTRY FEE

Entries will open 30th October 2024 at noon.

Junior & Senior: £550 per team Advanced Novice: £502 per team



Invoice will be sent within 7 days of entry and payments of full amount must be made to British Ice Skating – any charges as the entry teams' responsibility. No refunds will be given after closing date.

Entry fee does not include any extra practice ice, further information below regarding booking unofficial practice ice



PRELIMINARY ENTRIES

Preliminary entries must be submitted no later than **22**nd **of November 2024** at noon on the ISU ORS. If the OC has to limit the number of entries, priority will be given to those teams that have submitted the preliminary entries.

FINAL ENTRIES

All final entries and nominations must be made via the ISU ORS.

Finalised Entries: 05th December 2024 at noon.

Entries will be allocated a place in the competition on a 'first come, first served' basis upon your entry and payment.

ENTRIES AND NOMINATION/REGISTRATION

All entries for the Britannia Cup must be submitted via the ISU ORS by the indicated deadline.

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of teams per country per ISU Member or to refuse participation if the maximum number of teams that can take part in the competition is reached based on the date of the entries

Maximum 3 (three) teams per ISU Member in each category, (limitations not applicable for the host ISU Member) and maximum:

- 10 Advance Novice Teams
- 15 Junior Teams
- 15 Senior Team

WITHDRAWALS

Entries are strictly non-refundable and non-transferable after closing date. Before the closing date spaces will be refunded minus a £50.00 administration charge. This will be issued at the organizers convenience but should be no later than **2** weeks after the scheduled event has taken place.

OFFICIALS

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge, listed on the ISU List of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating. The Entries of Judges must be made via ORS no later than **05**th **December 2024.**

The host ISU Member may nominate a **second Judge** listed in the ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2024-2025

Travel expenses of the Judges are borne by their respective ISU Member or by themselves.

The Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators will be invited by the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee will cover travel expenses at APEX (advance purchase excursion) airfare economy rates for all invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators.

The rooms at Leonardo Hotel Nottingham for invited Referees/Technical Controllers/Technical Specialists/Data-Replay Operators and nominated Judges will be reserved by the Organizing Committee upon receipt of the entries.

The Organizing Committee will provide food and accommodation (Leonardo Hotel - Nottingham) from dinner on Thursday 09th January to Sunday 12th of January 2025.

All other expenses will be the responsibility of each individual Official. Should any Official arrive at the hotel before or stay after the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be their responsibility and must be paid upon arrival.

The Organizing Committee does not cover travel, accommodation and meal expenses for wives, husbands, relatives, etc.

The **Initial Judges Meeting** for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice events will be held on Friday 10th January at the Motorpoint Arena Nottingham.

The **Official Draw** will take place prior to the event beginning. This was be published on Sportity. The free programs will be skated in reverse order from the short programs.

Each participating ISU Member Federation is required to report to the organizer the name of the Team Leader designated for the nation/ISU member.

The Meeting for Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators will be held on Friday 10th January, at the Motorpoint Arena.

The **Technical Panel Review Meeting** for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice (Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators) will be held on Sunday 12th January post competition.

The **Round Table Discussion** for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice events will be held on Sunday, 12th January at Motorpoint Arena Nottingham post competition.

Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists are kindly requested to carefully plan well in advance their travel arrangements in order to attend the mandatory meetings.

MUSIC AND PLANNED PROGRAM FORMS

In accordance with Rule 823 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating, the team music has to be submitted to the OC as follows:

All teams have to provide their competition music of excellent quality as MP3 file format.

Music files are requested to be uploaded no later than 13th of December 2024.

Additionally, each team will need to bring their competition music on a clearly labelled USB drive as a backup. One USB drive for each program.

All music must be clearly identified with the name of the team and must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time).

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating must be entered by the ISU Member or by the teams on the dedicated ISU Portal.

The Planned Program Content must be entered by the ISU Member or the teams on the dedicated ISU Portal. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. The Planned Program Content must be entered with the final entry date.

RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Synchronized Skating 2022, Rule 842 and Rule 843 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

The Starting Order of the Free Skating will follow the reverse order of places in the short program.

PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES

The three best placed Teams in each event will be announced and honoured. The national anthem of the winners will be played, and the flags of the medal winners hoisted. Trophies will be awarded to the winners of all the categories. Medals will be presented to all teams in first, second and third places.

INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

British Ice Skating and the Organisers assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred by Competitors and Officials. The Organizing Committee reserve the right to cancel the event without liability. Should the competition have to be cancelled for any reason the organizer accepts no liability for any arrangements made or expenses incurred by attending skaters, coaches or family members. In accordance with ISU Rule 119 the organizer accepts no liability for injury or damages incurred by competitors or officials.

The organizer will provide medical emergency first aid during the competition. Please do not attend if you are unwell or have tested positive for COVID or any other contagious disease. All Skaters with medical conditions are obliged to inform the Event Organiser of these underlying conditions in order that the medical team be fully informed. Competitors/Officials must report any injuries to the reception desk personnel.

Competitors, parents and coaches are reminded that the judges, officials and helpers are all volunteers, without whom this competition would not be possible. Failure to treat them or any staff members with respect will result in the individual being expelled for the event.

By entering this event competitors consent to be photographed, the images used for reporting an event marketing purpose. They also consent to being recorded on video for judging purposes, live-streaming and video sales.

Unofficial videography and photography of the event is not permitted, and flash photography is banned at all times.
