PLACE: Palasesto, Piazza 1 Maggio, 20099 Sesto San Giovanni, Italy

The rink is an artificial heated indoor facility measuring 56 x 28 meters. An elevated platform for the Officials, as well as the entrance and exit points to the rink, are indicated in following plan:

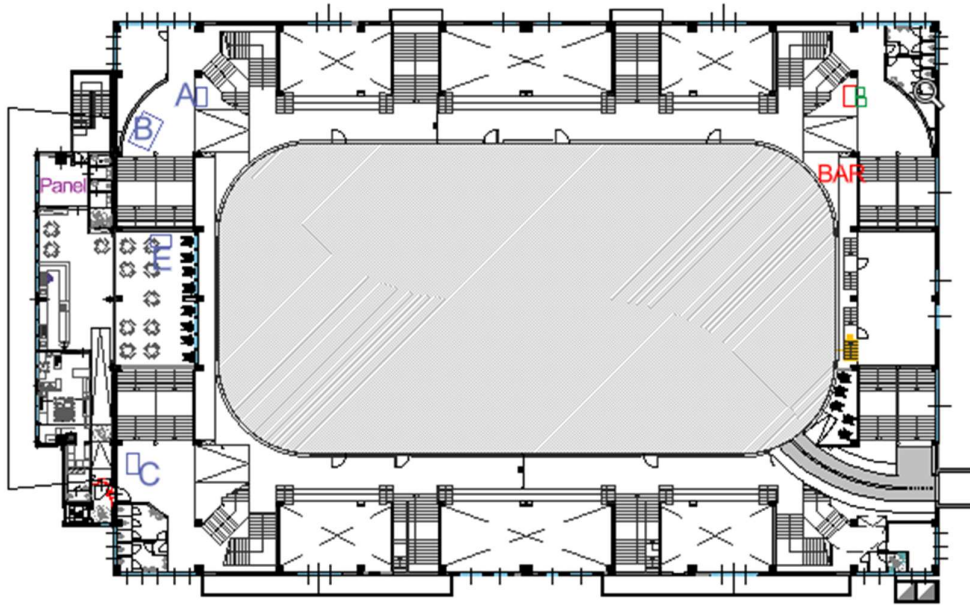


Figure 1_ Ground floor

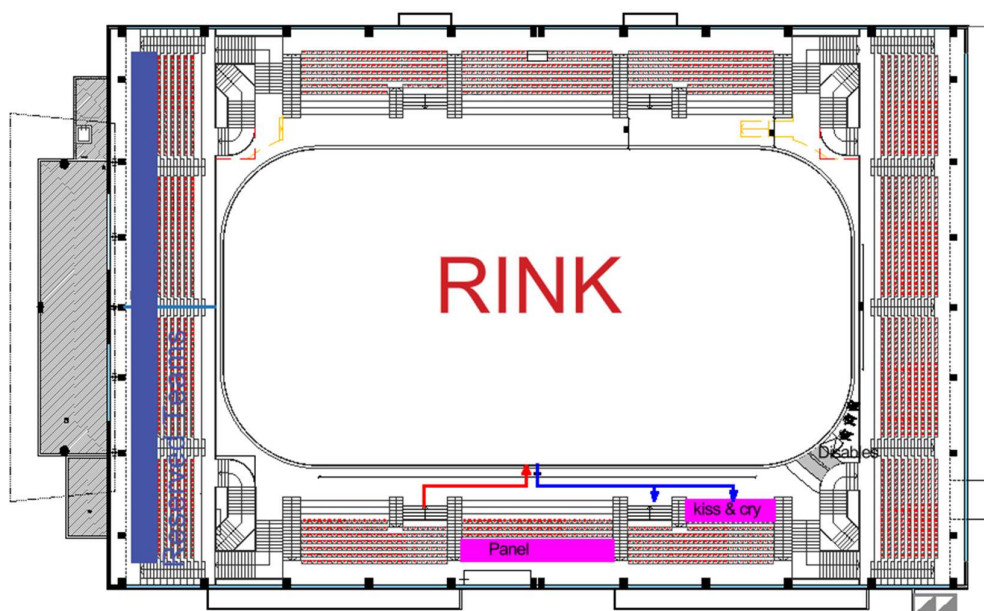


Figure 2_ Rink and Stands

Senior: Short Program and Free Skating

Senior Elite 12: Short Program and Free Skating

Advanced Novice: Free Skating

Mixed Age: Free Skating

1. GENERAL RULES

The Spring Cup 2026 will be conducted in accordance with the current 2024 ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the 2024 Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating and the relevant ISU Communications.

The teams must belong to an ISU Member, and the ages must fall within the limits specified in Rule 108. All skaters for all categories must qualify regarding eligibility according to Rule 102, and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109.

2. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

The following Categories are included:

ISU Senior: shall consist of 16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 17 before July 1st, 2025. If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 14 skaters.

Short Program: 2.50 min (may be less) Program Components Factor is 1.33

Free Skating: 4.00 min (+ / - 10 sec) Program Components Factor is 2.67

ISU Senior Elite 12: shall consist of 12 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 17 before July 1st, 2025. If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 skaters.

Short Program: 2.50 min (may be less) Program Components Factor is 1.33

Free Skating: 4.00 min (+ / - 10 sec) Program Components Factor is 2.67

SENIOR COMBINED

The categories Senior ISU and Senior Elite 12 ISU can be combined into the Senior Combined category in order to preserve points for the ISU World Standing and ISU World Ranking (Rule 800, paragraph 2. a)). The OC will communicate an intent to do so as soon as possible to all Senior and Senior Elite 12 teams if possible. The final decision to combine the two categories will be made by the Organizing Committee and communicated shortly after the registration deadline.

ISU Junior: shall consist of 12-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 13 but not have reached the age of 19 before July 1st,

2025. If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 skaters.

Short Program: 2.50 min (may be less), Program Components Factor is 1.33

Free Skating: 3.30 min (+ / - 10 sec) Program Components Factor is 2.67

Basic/Advanced Novice: shall consist of 12-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All skaters must have reached at least the age of 10 but not have reached the age of 16 before July 1st, 2025. If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 skaters.

Free Skating: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec) Program Components Factor is 2.67

Mixed Age: No age requirements, shall consist of 8 to 16 skaters + max 4 alternates

Program duration: 3 min. 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Teams may attempt any level. 3 Program Components. Program Components Factor is 2.67..

- Cash payment (in Euro) will be allowed.

4. ENTRIES AND NOMINATION/REGISTRATION

All entries for the Spring Cup 2026 must be submitted through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the indicated deadline. Declarations will need to be uploaded to the ORS as well.

If you have any problems concerning the registration via the ORS please contact the Organizing Committee (OC) of the Spring Cup 2026 via e-mail: oc@springcup.it

The OC reserves the right to limit the number of teams per country per ISU Member or to refuse participation if the maximum number of teams that can take part in the competition is reached based on the date of the entries.

The OC will reserve to limit the number of entries, and the priority will be given to the teams that have submitted the preliminary entry within the requested deadline of preliminary entry and that have subsequently submitted the entry within the deadline and based on the first come first served.

In accordance to rule 109, up to 25% (four Skaters on a Team with sixteen Skaters and three Skaters on a Team with twelve Skaters) may be member of an ISU Member different from the one the Team is competing for, provided they have a respective permit from the ISU Member they belong to. Alternates are excluded from the calculation.

Preliminary Entry

The preliminary entry form must be submitted no later than October 15th, 2025 by entering the information through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS).

Team entries by names not preceded by the respective preliminary entries will not be accepted.

Final Entry

All final entries and nominations must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) no later than December 1st, 2025.

Each participating ISU Member Federation is required to report to the organizer the name of the Team Leader designated for the nation/ISU member – Form Team contacts - Form 1.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to accept late entries at its sole discretion.

Teams must submit a high-resolution digital team photo with their final registration.

5. OFFICIALS

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge, listed in the current ISU List of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating. The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) and reach the Organizing Committee, no later than December 1st, 2025.

The host ISU Member may nominate a second Judge listed in the current ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating.

Travel expenses of the Judges are borne by their respective ISU Member or by themselves.

The Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators will be invited by the Organizing Committee.

The Organizing Committee will cover travel expenses at APEX (advance purchase excursion) airfare economy rates for all invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators.

The rooms at **HOTEL ABACUS** for invited Referees/Technical Controllers/Technical Specialists/Data-Replay Operators and nominated Judges will be reserved by the Organizing Committee upon receipt of the entries.

The Organizing Committee will provide the accommodation and breakfast for invited Referees/Technical Controllers/Technical Specialists/Data-Replay Operators and nominated Judges at **HOTEL ABACUS**, while the food will be provided at the ice rink, except the dinner on January 16th, 2026.

All other expenses will be the responsibility of each individual Official. Should any Official arrive at the hotel before or stay after the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be their responsibility and must be paid upon arrival.

The Organizing Committee does not cover travel, accommodation and meal expenses for wives, husbands, relatives, etc.

Referees, Technical Panel and Judges, are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but no later than December 1st, 2025, dates, times and place of arrival or any other information concerning their trips to the Spring Cup 2026.

The Meeting for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators will be held on Friday, January 16th, 2026, at 7:15pm at HOTEL ABACUS.

The Technical Panel Review Meeting (Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators) will be held on Sunday, January 18th, 2026 at 8:30pm at the ICE RINK (Technical Panel Room).

The Round Table Discussion events will be held on Sunday, January 18th, 2026, at 9pm at HOTEL ABACUS.

Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data/Replay Operators are kindly requested to carefully plan well in advance their travel arrangements in order to attend the mandatory meetings.

7. PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT SHEETS

The Planned Program Content must be submitted by the ISU Member or the Team(s) through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS). It is mandatory that each Team completes the Program Content form accurately and in English, using the official element terminology as published in the relevant ISU Communication.

8. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 823 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating, the team music must be submitted to the OC as follows:

Music files are requested to be sent no later than December 1st, 2025.

Additionally, each team will need to bring their competition music on a clearly labelled USB drive as a backup. One USB drive for each program.

The USB drive must be submitted by the Team Manager or Team Leader at the time of registration. All music must be clearly identified with the name of the team and must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time).

11. ACCREDITATION

The registration for Teams, Coaches, Team Leaders, and Team Managers will take place at the designated registration office in the PALASESTO Arena on January 16th, 2026, from 2pm to 9 pm and on January 17th, 2026, from 9am to 12 pm.

All team members will need to identify themselves by a passport when registering at the event.

Copies of the passports (ISU categories) and of the Identity Cards (NON ISU categories) have to be collected for the Referee of the competition.

Each team is entitled to four (4) additional accreditations (Coach, Team Leader, Team Medical Staff, etc.)

Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, and Data/Replay Operators' registration will take place at the official hotel. Upon arrival, each Official will receive an envelope containing their accreditation badge and all necessary information regarding the competition as well as details about the dinner schedule for January 16th, 2026.

13. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) is described in 2024 Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating.

The Starting Order of the Free Skating will follow the reverse order of places in the Short Program.

14. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES

The medal ceremony will take place immediately after the conclusion of all competitions. The top three teams in each category will be announced and honored with gold, silver, and bronze medals or trophies. The national anthem of the winning team will be played, and the flags of the medalists will be hoisted. All participants will receive a commemorative medal.

The prizes are symbolic and serve as a tribute to sporting excellence and a formal recognition of merit.

15. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team.

Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue of who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

16. ANTI DOPING

An anti-doping control may be carried out during the competition and will be in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Rules.

17. PUBLICITY WAIVER

Members, officials, teams, and competitors hereby acknowledge and consent to the fact that team photos, team information and results will be published, as well as that the Spring Cup 2026, may be televised or live streamed either in whole or in part, for showing on a worldwide basis.

According to the current ISU Constitution, both members and competitors (in this case, teams) hereby certify and warrant that the music and choreography presented and used by the competitors have been fully cleared and authorized for public use.
