### **ANNOUNCEMENT 31st French Cup 2025 BIS**

The French Ice Sports Federation and Rouen Olympic Club (ROC), represented by Nicolas PAYSANT, have the great pleasure to inform all ISU members that we will organize the 31<sup>st</sup> French Cup from Friday November, 28<sup>th</sup> 2025 until Saturday November, 29<sup>th</sup> 2025.

This International Synchronized Skating Competition will take place at Rouen, Ice Rink – Centre Sportif Guy Boissiere-Avenue Jacques Chastellain 76000 Rouen.

She will include the following categories:

- Senior ISU
- Senior Elite 12 ISU
- Junior ISU
- Advanced Novice ISU

### **GENERAL RULES**

The 31<sup>st</sup> French Cup 2025 BIS will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations 2024, and Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating 2024 and the relevant ISU Communications. The teams must belong to an ISU Member, and the ages must be within the limits specified in Rule 108. All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102 and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109. This is for all categories.

### **TECHNICAL DATA**

The technical data for all categories are:

- > Senior ISU and Senior Elite 12: according to ISU regulations.
  - At least 17 years before the 1st of July 2025, 16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.
  - Short Program 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less Factor 1.33
  - Free Skating program 4 minutes (+/- 10 sec) Factor 2.67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2635 Senior Short Program and Senior Free Skating.

Junior ISU: according to ISU regulations.

At least 13 years and have not reached the age of 19 before the 1st of July 2025, 12-16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

- Short Program 2 minutes and 50 seconds but may be less Factor 1.33
- Free Skating program 3 minutes 30 seconds (+/- 10 sec) Factor 2.67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2635 Junior Short Program and Junior Free Skating.

Advanced Novice ISU: according to ISU regulations.

At least 10 years and have not reached the age of 16 before the 1st of July 2025, 12-16 skaters with a maximum of 4 alternates.

• Free Skating program 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec) Factor 2.67

Well Balanced Program Content according to Communication 2635 Advanced Novice Free Skating.

### **SENIOR COMBINED**

The categories Senior ISU and Senior Elite 12 ISU can be combined into the Senior Combined category in order to preserve points for the ISU World Standing and ISU World Ranking (Rule 800, paragraph 2. a)). The OC will communicate an intent to do so as soon as possible to all Senior and Senior Elite 12 teams if possible. The final decision to combine the two categories will be made by the Referee of the Senior category and communicated at the draw for the Short Program.

### **VENUE**

The competition will be held at Rouen, in France:

- Main arena: Nathalie Pechalat Rouen ice-rink (an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 30 x 60 m, air-conditioned and heated)
- Practice arena: Edith Ballester Rouen ice-rink (an indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 26 x 56 m, air-conditioned and heated)

Main and Practice Rink are in the same complex.

### **ENTRY FEE**

Advanced Novice : € 600 per team Senior Elite 12, Senior ISU, Junior ISU : € 700 per team

These entry fees do not include any extra practice ice.

The payment of the entry fee must be received on the bank account of ROC – Organizing Committee of French Cup latest at the final closing date of entries on the **Tuesday September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2025** by credit transfer (the bank draft expenses will be charged to the registering teams and not to the organiser of the competition). No refunds can be given after the **Tuesday September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2025**. The team registration will be valid only after payment of the entry fee.

Teams that sent in the pre-entry in an earlier stage are urgently requested to inform the organisation if the team will not participate in the end. Please notify the organisation as soon as possible but before the **Tuesday September 23**<sup>rd</sup> **2025**.

### **SPORTITY APP**

During the competition the Sportity app will be used for announcing all information regarding the competition. The Sportity app can be downloaded from the Google and Apple playstores.





### **UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE**

Unofficial practice ice for all teams is available on Tuesday, November 25<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday November 26<sup>th</sup> and Thursday November 27<sup>th</sup> 2025 at Nathalie Pechalat Rouen ice-rink and Edith Ballester Rouen ice-rink. For earlier unofficial practice ice please contact us. It is possible to reserve practice ice per block of 15 minutes. Costs are € 70 per block which is available on Wednesday and Thursday. Please use the online form provided to order any practice ice on this <u>link</u>. Extra practice ice must be paid in advance directly after reservation request.

### **PROGRAM CONTENT SHEETS**

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be submitted through ORS to the Organizing Committee in time. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be filled in precisely by each Team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

### **LIST OF TEAM MEMBERS**

The names of all team members must be submitted via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) and must reach the Organizing Committee (<u>link</u>) and the ISU Secretariat not later than **Tuesday**, **September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2025 – 20:00 h (Central European (Paris) Time**, **UTC+1)**.

The national passport of each skater of the teams taking part in the competition will be checked during the accreditation. Names of team members can be adjusted up until accreditation.

### **JUDGES & OFFICIALS**

The panel of Judges is composed for each category of:

- 1 Referee
- 5-7 Judges
- 1 Technical Controller
- 2 Technical Specialists
- 2 Data/Replay operators

Each participant country may enter one judge. Travel, accommodation, and meals will be paid for the Technical Panel and the Referee by the organizing committee as well as the accommodation and meals for the judges. Teams are invited to bring judges as well as technical panels. Please be aware that all judges must be nominated through ORS **before the closing date for the final entry date**.

### JUDGES AND TECHNICAL PANEL MEETING

The Initial Judges Meeting and Initial Technical Panel Meeting are planned to take place at Radisson Blu Hotel-Rouen, on the evening of Thursday November 27<sup>th</sup> 2025.

### **STARTING ORDER/DRAW**

The starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done on Thursday November 27<sup>th</sup> 2025 and will be published on the competition website, competition Facebook page, and Sportity app not later than 23:59 PM. The starting order for the Free Skating will be in reversed order of the result of the Short Program for all categories.

### **OFFICIAL PRACTICE**

Each team will be allocated a period of official practice on the competition rink described in the table below:

### The music will start:

- In the practice of 10 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 6:00 minutes
- In the practice of 11 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 6:30 minutes
- In the practice of 12 minutes: After 1:30 minutes and after 7:00 minutes

The organizing committee intends to plan all official practices on the same day as the competition for all programs of all categories. The schedule will depend on the number of teams taking part in the competition.

### **MUSIC**

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality by email in MP3 format only, in accordance with Rule 823. A list of titles, composers, and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program must be listed for each Team on the official Music Selection Form and attached to the official Entry Form for Teams.

The MP3 files shall be named: <Program>\_<category>\_<country abbreviation>\_<team name>.mp3 For example: Short\_Senior\_NED\_Team\_Illumination.mp3.

In accordance with Rule 823, all Teams must announce the exact running time of the music, (not skating time), which shall be certified by the Team, Coach, Team Manager or Team Leader at the time of registration.

In addition, Teams must provide at registration a backup for each program in MP3 format on a separate USB thumb drive for each program. The thumb drives shall be formatted for Windows (NTFS, FAT32, or exFAT) with only the MP3 file of the program in the main (root) directory, without other files or directories.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given. We request all teams to check the music submitted at accreditation.

The music files will be deleted by the organizers shortly after the competition. The backup thumb drives will be returned to the teams at the info desk.

### **VICTORY CEREMONY**

A victory ceremony will be held right after the last skating program of the day. Trophies will be awarded to the top three teams in each category. All skaters of all teams are invited to take part in the closing ceremony on the ice. We will fill you in with the details at a later stage.

### **PRIZE MONEY**

1<sup>st</sup> Senior : 2.600 € 1<sup>st</sup> Junior : 2.100 € 1<sup>st</sup> Novice : 1.000 €

FREE INVITATION to take part to the next FRENCH CUP 2027 is offered to all category, placed at second place at the Final Result in their category of the 31<sup>st</sup> FRENCH CUP 2025 BIS.

### **PROVISIONAL TIME SCHEDULE**

A provisional time schedule will be published after the closing date of the entry. The intention of the organizing committee is to follow the days as stated in the provisional event schedule at the end of this document.

### **REGISTRATION & ACCREDITATION**

All participating teams and officials are invited to register for accreditation from Wednesday November 26<sup>th</sup> 2025 or Thursday November 27<sup>th</sup> 2025 at Ice Rink – Centre Sportif Guy Boissière-Rouen. A welcoming/accreditation/info desk will be in place at the ice rink from Thursday the November 27<sup>th</sup> and during the whole competition. Every team will receive passes for team members as mentioned in the team list. Every team will also receive passes for 1 team manager, 1 coach, 1 co-coach, 2 team chaperones and 1 team medical through ORS.

Every ISU Member can bring one Team Leader to the International Competition. The Team Leader (one per nation) must be announced through ORS.

### **TICKETS**

Tickets can be ordered in advance on the website. Tickets are also available at the event.

### **DOPING**

An anti-doping control can take place and will be in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Rules. It is also not permitted to use alcohol during the competition by any of the competitors.
