from Friday, February 21, to Sunday, February 23, 2025

The Competition will be held under the 2024 ISU General Regulations, Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2653.

This World Cup Competition will serve as one of the qualifying events for quota places at the ISU World Speed Skating Championships 2024, Single Distances & Team Competitions format.

\* The actual starting times for the B Division races will be announced during the Online Team leaders' meetings. For each distance, the races of Division A and the races of Division B are considered as two separate competitions with independent final classifications (list of results) for determining the awarding of World Cup points and prize money.

**TRACK**

Arena Lodowa is an indoor artificially frozen ice rink with a standard track of 400 meters and inner and outer curves with radii of 26 and 30 meters respectively. The width of the inside training track is 4 meters. In accordance with Rue 228 a protective moveable padding system will be installed around the track.

## ENTRIES

Entries for these competitions will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraph 3.1.

Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events on <https://ssk-entries.isu.org/> and respecting the following deadlines:

**Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628, need to be strictly observed.**

For more details, please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communications No. 1628 and 1797 or any update of this Communications.

**In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.**

ISU Speed Skating Members not listed in the table above, may enter a maximum of 1 Skater for each distance<sup>1</sup>. All entered Skaters (incl. substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances according to the criteria given in Communication No. 2653, paragraph 3.1.2.

<sup>1</sup> Reference is made to ISU Communication No. 2469, paragraph 2.a) according to which and until further notice, no individual belonging to the Russian Skating Union and Skating Union of Belarus shall be invited, entered and allowed to participate in International Competitions, ISU Championships and other ISU Events.

## COMPETITION FORMAT AND SAFETY MEASURES FOR THE MASS START EVENTS

Mass Start races will be skated according to Rule 257 and Rule 265, paragraph 6 in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraph 5.6, with distances of 16 laps for both Women

and Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2636 or any further updates.

### **COMPETITION FORMAT FOR THE TEAM SPRINT EVENTS**

Team Sprint races will be skated according to Rule 256, paragraph 2 and Rule 265, paragraph 7 in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraphs 4.2 and 5.7, with teams of 3 Skaters each, and with distances of 3 laps both for Women and for Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2636 or any further updates.

### **GROUPING AND DRAWING PROCEDURES**

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be made according to ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraph 5.

### **PRIZES AND POINTS**

For each event, World Cup points and prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraphs 6 and 7.2 accordingly.

### **ANTI-DOPING**

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

### **TRAINING TIMES**

The speed skating track and gym facilities will be open for training for entered Competitors from Monday, February 17, 2025. Trial starts will be organized on Thursday, February 20, 2025.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

ISU Members may ask for changes in the training schedule (published in the Inside ISU Events' App) latest by Thursday, February 14, 2025. Decisions on changes' request will be taken by the Organizing Committee in consultation with the ISU.

### **LIABILITY**

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, Polish Speed Skating Association and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage incurred in connection with the ISU World Cup Speed Skating. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

Participating ISU Members will have to bear expenses for accommodation for all participating Skaters and team officials.

The cost of a room and meals at the official hotel(s) will be as follows (including all taxes):

*Single Room occupancy: 135,- Euro per person per night. Price including meals and drinks.*

*Single Room occupancy: 160,- Euro per person per night. Price including meals and drinks.*  
*Double Room occupancy; 135,- Euro per person per night. Price including meals and drinks.*

Payment: Cash in [PLN, EUR or USD] or credit card [VISA, Mastercard +2% handling charges].

All arrangements for accommodation must be made through the Organizing Committee.

Accommodation requests can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

Please indicate the preferred hotel in the OES notes per booking.

Based on the request entered in the ISU Online Entry System and availability the OC will prepare and send you the summary of accommodation costs. The OC may ask for the 50% prepayment to confirm your booking.

Cancellation policy:

- Before January 20: 50% of rooms can be cancelled free of charge
- January 20 - February 15: 10% of rooms can be cancelled free of charge
- After February 15.: No refund after this date

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of hotel rooms available to each team at the official hotel(s).

## TRANSPORTATION

Information about the date and time of arrival and departure (incl. flight details) of the competitors and team officials must be submitted via the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

On request (via OES) the Organizing Committee will provide bus transportation from Sunday, February 16, until Monday, February 24, 2025, between Warsaw International Airport "Chopin" or Warsaw Central Railway Station and the official hotels for the price:

- 40€ per person for the group of 4 or more / one way
- 70€ per person for the group of up to 3 person / one way.
- 125€ for a single person service / one way.

The Organization Committee will provide free transportation for all participants between the official hotels and the Arena Lodowa during the competition days and the training periods, starting from Monday, February 17, 2025.

## VISA REQUIREMENTS

The organizer is not obliged to provide services (accommodation, accredited entrance to the ice rink, transportation, etc.) for an excessive number of team officials or other accompanying persons from participating ISU Members. A fee of EUR 250 for each additional Team Officials/Federation Officials accreditation must be paid to the Organizing Committee.
