ANNOUNCEMENT

Merano Ice Trophy Memorial Martina Barricelli is an annual ISU International Competition in Italy organized by the local figure skating club ASM Pattinaggio (Associazione Sportiva Merano Sezione Pattinaggio) and the Italian Skating Federation (FISG). The goal of this event is to bring Skating Family to the beautiful city of Merano in the heart of Italian Alps. The local OC has the experience in organizing such events like Junior Grand Prix and World Championship. This event is dedicated to Martina Barricelli who was a coach at the ASM club since its beginning and sadly passed away.

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Merano Ice Trophy will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Singles & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, as well as all pertinent ISU Communications. Participation in the competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108 paragraph 3. b) and they meet the participation citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification. All participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate the participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, sex.

Entries can only be made through the ISU Members.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

3. CATEGORIES

SENIOR WOMEN AND MEN

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2024/2025

Duration: 2 min. 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.

SENIOR PAIRS

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2024/2025

Duration: 2 min. 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR WOMEN AND MEN

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2024/25.

Duration: 2 min. 40 sec. +/-10 sec.

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 3 min, 30 sec. +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR PAIRS

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 620.

Duration: 2 min. 40 sec. +/-10 sec.

Free Skating: in accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value.

Duration: 3 min, 30 sec. +/- 10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS AND BOYS

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in the ISU Communication No. 2624 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min, 20 sec. +/-10 sec

Free Skating: Special attention should be paid to the contents of a well-balanced program listed in ISU Communication No. 2624 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3:00 min, +/- 10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICE PAIRS

Short Program: In accordance with ISU Communication No. 2624 or any subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 20 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Communication 2624 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min. +/- 10 sec.

4. ENTRIES

The Entries by names must be made via ISU Online Registration System (ORS):

The Federations must send to the OC a copy of their passport and PPC document at the time of entries, as well as ISU Clearance Certificate if applicable. Each Guest Federation can enter maximum 3 competitor per category plus 1 substitute, No limits for Italian Federation. Depending on the number of participants. The Organizing Committee will decide whether or not to accept extra entries. The OC reserves the right to accept more than 3 competitors per event where time permits.

The Organizing Committee reserves the option in the competition to allow late entries in Senior Ladies and Men, reserved for competitors preparing for the World Figure Skating championships, and/or needing the competition to obtain the minimum technical scores. A reserve-list will be kept up to date on a daily basis.

Entries must reach the Event Organizer not later than JANUARY 24th, 2025.

4.1 ENTRIES OF JUDGES

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate one judge per discipline who has at least the qualification "Judge for International Competitions". In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date of entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved on writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) not later than: **January 24th, 2025**.

4.2 JUDGES EXPENSES, MEALS, LODGING

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for Judges and invited officials participating, beginning with dinner on **February 12, 2025**, and ending with lunch (and dinner if necessary) on **February 16, 2025**.

The expenses for rooms and meals for the Team Leader, Coaches, Competitors and other team officials will not be covered by the organizer and are on the account of the team.

Should any Judge or invited Official arrive at the hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for travel, rooms and meals also for the invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

All extra expenses incurred by any Official will be the responsibility of that person and must be paid prior to departure.

4.3 CANCELLATION

Cancellation of competitors must be done within **JANUARY 30th 2025**. For any later cancellation the team leader of respective Federation **will be asked to pay the entry fee**.

5. ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee must be paid **not later January 30th, 2025**.

7. MUSIC

the participating member is responsible for submitting their competitor's music (.mp3) as direct attachment to an e-mail to the Organizing Committee – E-mail: merano.icetrophy@gmail.com.

The music must reach the organizer until February 1st 2025

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2:

All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality in MP3 format.

- a) The Competitor must announce the exact running time of the music (not skating time), which shall be certified by the Competitor, Coach or Team Leader, at the time of registration;
- b) Each program (Short Program/Free Program/Pattern Dance when music provided by the Couple/Rhythm Dance/Free Dance) must be recorded on a separate track
- c) Competitors must provide a back-up drive for each program in MP3 format.

All musics shall be labelled according to the following format:

<Category>_<Segment:SP/FS>_<ISU Member>_<name(s) of competitor(s)>_<Running time>

example: Men_SP_GER_Mustermann_02.40

If music information is not complete as requested, accreditation will not be given.

Together with the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee (Via Mail to: merano.icetrophy@gmail.com).

It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet is completed precisely by each skater/pair in English using the terminology listed in the respective ISU Communication.

8. LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials.

Furthermore, the OC is not responsible for any contagion that occurs at the event outside of compliance with the prevention protocols implemented.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2025 Merano IceTrophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must be assuring full medical attendance and the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

9. ACCREDITATION

The accreditation will be taking place at the Meranarena Ice rink (the OC office upstairs above the bar) starting on

10. DRAW

The draw for Pairs and Advanced Novice Girls and Boys will be organized at the Meranarena Ice Rink on Wednesday, February 12th at 20:00 in the OC office room. Starting order for the free skating of all the categories will be in reverse order of the results of the short program.

The draw for Men and Women (Junior and Senior) will be organized at Meranarena Ice Rink on Friday 14th at 18:00 in the OC office room. Starting order for the free skating of all the categories will be in reverse order of results of the short program.

11. AWARDING CEREMONY

The three best placed skaters/couples in each event will be announced and honored.

There will be a small medal ceremony after the ending of Short Program Segment for Men and Woman Junior and Senior.
