»TIVOLI CUP« Interclub competition in Free Skating only for categories:

- Intermediate Novice (boys and girls)
- Basic Novice (Boys and girls)
- Cubs (boys and girls)
- Chicks (boys and girls)

Location of competition: Ice rink ZALOG, Hladilniška pot 36,1000 Ljubljana

Ice rink is covered and heated, 60 x 30 m, capacity 300 spectators,

located 12 km from the center of Ljubljana.

Entries: Each Club (member of ISU Member Federation), may enter unlimited

competitors in each category.









The Organizer reserves the right to enter more competitors in each category. The number of competitors could be also reduced in case of too many entries on »first come first serve basis«.

Entries should contain: name and surname of competitor, date of birth, category and title of music of his program. Only complete entries will be accepted.

If the club would like to entry competitor in older category, this must be specified in entry form. If not, the competitor will be in the group according to the date of birth.

Deadline for entries:

The entries should arrive to the Slovene Skating Union and to the Organizer Figure and Roller Skating Club Stanko Bloudek in copies, not later than on:

10th January 2025.

Late entries will be accepted only by special agreement between Skating Club and Organizer.

**Cancelation:** Cancelation of the competitor entry, if any, has to be done latest until

27<sup>th</sup> January <u>, 2025</u>.

For any late cancellation after 1st February 2025, or no-show at the

competition, entry fee will not be returned.

**Prizes:** Competitors placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> will be awarded with medals and diplomas

Judges: Each participating Club may nominate one, at least National Judge. In

case of too many nominated judges, the organizer will draw the panels of judges after the entries closing date and a written confirmation will

immediately be sent to each federation/club.

Judges meeting will be held before each category and round table

**discussion** will be held as soon as possible after each category.

**Responsibilities:** In accordance with the ISU Regulations 2024, Rule 119, all participants

act on their own responsibility. The organizer will provide medical

emergency aid during competition and practice.

#### Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure:

In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations 2024 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

The local organizing committee has the right and obligation to check the personal identification documents of the athletes to determine whether they are allowed to compete, whether they are competing in the right category, etc. Without the documents, the athlete will be









excluded from the competition. Before first draw, the passport or other Schengen valid document has to be present to the organizer.

Music:

Music should be sent on club's official email address <a href="mailto:entries@drsanje.si">entries@drsanje.si</a>
in MP3 format in accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024. The following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee <a href="mailto:must">must</a> be followed: - the ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (entries@drsanje.si) until 1st February 2025. - each submitted file with music <a href="mailto:must">must</a> be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name of the competitor according to the examples below:

the music files must be sent as MP3 file format. Any other format is not acceptable. The Organizing Committee is not responsible, if the quality of the music sent would be insufficient. - Each Competitor must have their own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a MP3 file or CD in audio format. - The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.

**Judging System:** The ISU Judging System will be used.

**Expenses:** The full board hotel accommodation (M Hotel) for the Referees, Judges,

Technical Controllers and Specialists will be arranged and born by the organizer from the dinner on Wednesday, February 6, till the breakfast on Monday, February 10, 2025. Travel costs for Referees and Judges are to be covered by the club or the respective National Federation. The Organizer will not be able to cover any expense for competitors, team

leaders and coaches.

### INTERMEDIATE NOVICE Boys and Girls born from 1. 7. 2008 and younger.

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, ISU Communication 2624 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: Duration: 3 min, +\- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE Boys and Girls: born from 1. 7. 2010 and younger.

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, ISU

Communication 2624 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: Duration: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CUBS Boys and Girls: born from 1. 7. 2014 – 30. 6. 2016. Free Skating:

Duration: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

#### A well balanced Free Skating program for CUBS Boys and Girls must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or one (1) jump combination and one (1) jump sequence. Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump in to the take- off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value.
  - No triple and quadruple jumps are allowed.
  - Only one single jump and one double jump (including Double Axel) can be repeated once.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin with no change of position and no change of foot. The spin combination with a change of foot must have a minimum of eight (8) revolutions and without a change of foot with a minimum of six (6) revolutions. Flying entry is allowed. If with change of foot, only one level feature per foot will count. The spin in one position without change of foot must have a minimum of six (6) revolutions, must be done in a basic position without any difficult variation positions and will be called maximum level basic. After the required revolutions it is allowed to execute difficult variations, but these will be ignored by the Technical Panel. Flying entry is not allowed.

Jump combinations and the jump sequence consist of two (2) jumps. In the jump sequence the second jump must be an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump in to the take- off curve of the Axel jump. One full revolution on the ice between the jumps (free foot can touch the ice, but without weight transfer) keeps the element in the frame of the definition of a jump sequence. Jumps executed in a jump sequence receive their full value.
