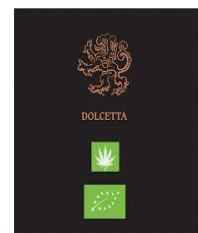

ANNOUNCEMENT / INVITATION

WELCOME

The Organizing Committee are glad to invite you and your club to participate in the Volvo Open Cup 54th International Competition.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Volvo Open Cup 54th** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Volvo Open Cup 54th** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation. Clubs registered at ISU Members Federations can participate in competition or Invited clubs ONLY. The OC can have a final design about over quota for any club/country/federation or refuse to accept the entry (full or partially). WOMEN	Short Program	The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2. Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.
	Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value. Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR MEN	Short Program	The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2024/2025. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.
	Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.
JUNIOR WOMEN	Short Program	The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2024/2025. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.
	Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

ENTRIES OF COMPETITORS

All the members of ISU being members of National Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in this competition.

Members can enter any quantity of Skaters into each category.

Organizers have the right to refuse or limit the participation in competition.

The Entries by names must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) not later than Friday, 20th December 2024-22.00 h. (local time Riga)

ENTRY FEE

90 EUR per skater (Men, Women, Junior)

Late Entry Fee: 120 EUR per skater (Men, Women, Junior)

Notice: All Entry Fee payments received after December 20th, 2024 are subject to late entry fee of 30€ per single skater. The late entry fee is not applicable only if a Member Federation or Club is substituting a skater, which entry fee was received by the deadline for another skater.

ENTRY FEE PAYMENT

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation. Bill must be paid with one (1) transaction for all the country/member participants.

The entry fee will not be refunded after the deadline in case of withdrawals for any reason.

APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS / ENTRTIES OF JUDGES

This Volvo Open Cup 54th event will follow the principles of International Skating Union for appointing the event officials. The members of each individual Technical Panel, Referee and Judges will have at least the qualification "International".

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge with the qualification "Judge for International competitions" or "ISU Judge" per discipline, double duty Judges are very welcome. We cover hotel`s/meal/pocket money ONLY for Judges who are acting in several panels except those where own federation skaters are presented

The Panels of Judges will consist of five (5) Judges in all panels.

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

PRACTISE

Extra fee: 30.- Euro / 30 min. person, with music (Senior and Junior). All the other categories can have practices by request and NO MUSIC. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration

MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENTS

All competitors shall furnish by December 25th, 2024 competition music of excellent quality via email to musicvolvocup@gmail.com The music files must be sent as MP3, M4A or WAV format and. Any other format is not acceptable. In accordance with Rule 343 paragraph 2. must have Competitor`s name, Member`s name, Segment, Category and the exact running time of the Music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration.

Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) in the format of a MP3, M4A or WAV format.

If music information is not complete and music not provided, accreditation will not be given. With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee. (Kristal_ice@hello.lv), It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be completed precisely by each skater/couple in English using the proper terminology.

DRAW

The Starting orders will be drawn by the representative of 2 Team Leaders for the short program. Starting orders for the second segment FS will be reverse order of the result of SP.

EXPENSES

Competitors

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

The nearest airport is Riga International Airport (RIX) with a distance of 8 km to the official hotel and 7 km to the venue.

RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

AWARDS

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honored and awarded by Trophies, special presents and diplomas; others will receive memory presents.

The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please make sure that all skaters are represented at the Ceremony.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Volvo Open Cup 54th, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.
