PROVISIONAL QUOTA PLACES SHORT TRACK SPEED SKATING

2024 WINTER YOUTH OLYMPIC GAMES (YOG) GANGWON/KOR – JANUARY 19-FEBRUARY 1, 2024

The Qualification Systems for the 4th Winter Youth Olympic Games (hereafter called YOG) for all three ISU disciplines (Figure Skating, Speed Skating and Short Track Speed Skating) have been approved by the IOC Executive Board. Detailed information has been communicated by the IOC to the National Olympic Committees (NOCs) and is posted on the ISU website.

A total of 68 athletes will be admitted as participants for Short Track Speed Skating.

The age limit for Short Track Speed Skating is as follows:

- Born between July 1, 2006 and June 30, 2008

ISU Members/NOCs are requested to take these age restrictions into account when confirming or rejecting YOG Quota Places and when entering the athletes.

ISU Members (hereafter referred to as Members) are referred to further details concerning the YOG that can be found on the ISU website.

On the basis of the ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships 2023 the qualifying process has been concluded and an initial set of YOG Quota Places has been assigned to the respective NOCs/Members.

In accordance with the YOG Qualifying System the ISU herewith announces the provisional YOG Quota Places for entries to the YOG 2024 for Short Track Speed Skating.

3. Timeline for acceptance/rejection of allocated YOG Quota Places and entries

a) By February 20, 2023 – Members/NOCs to confirm acceptance/rejection of allocated YOG Quota Places to ISU.

b) March 1, 2023 – Reallocation Period - In the case of ISU Members/NOCs informing ISU of not using certain YOG Quota Places, ISU to re-allocate such unused YOG Quota Places to the Members/NOCs according to the Stand-by Quota Places list. ISU Members/NOCs being offered an unused Quota Place to react within 24 hours of receipt of the ISU notification.

c) December 15, 2023 – ISU to announce confirmed use of allocated and reallocated quota places.

d) January 5, 2024 – Gangwon 2024 Sport Entries deadline.
