This document provides information for media representatives wishing to cover the Lombardia Trophy 2026. Accreditation is intended for legitimate editorial and sports-news coverage.

## 1. Media accreditation

Applications must be submitted no later than 31 August 2026 (23:59 CEST).

- Submitting the form does not automatically guarantee accreditation.
- The Organizing Committee will review each request and confirm approval by email.
- Accreditation requests will not be accepted by telephone.
- Accreditation is personal and non-transferable. A valid photo ID may be requested when collecting the credential.
- Applications received after the deadline may be considered only subject to operational availability.

## 2. Accreditation categories

| Category                | Typical role                         | Expected access                                                       |
|-------------------------|--------------------------------------|-----------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Written / digital press | Journalist, editor                   | Press working area, press seating and mixed zone, as authorized       |
| Photographer            | Still photographer                   | Designated photographers' areas and press working area, as authorized |
| TV / radio / video      | Reporter, producer, camera operator  | Areas specifically authorized by the Organizing Committee             |
| Other media             | Podcast, agency or specialist outlet | Access determined according to the nature of the assignment           |

*Access areas may be adjusted for safety, available space, broadcast rights or competition operations. Detailed access instructions will be provided with the accreditation confirmation or at the venue.*

### 3. Editorial use and media rights

- Accreditation is granted for editorial coverage of the event. Commercial, promotional or other non-editorial use requires prior written authorization.
- Competition video and broadcast rights are protected. Live streaming, full-program recording, re-streaming or distribution of competition footage is not permitted without specific authorization.
- Photographs may be used only in connection with the accredited outlet and assignment. Photographer credits should be included whenever images are published.
- The Organizing Committee may request links or copies of published coverage following the event.

### 4. Photographers and camera operators

- Photographers and camera operators must work only from the areas assigned to them and follow the instructions of media and venue staff.
- Flash photography is not permitted during practices or competition.
- Tripods or other equipment that may obstruct sightlines or movement require prior authorization. Monopods may be used only when space and safety conditions allow.
- Accreditation cards, bibs or rink-side passes must remain visible and must be returned when requested.

### 5. Mixed zone and interviews

- Interviews may be conducted only in the designated mixed-zone or interview areas.
- Requests for individual interviews should be submitted to the OC. The Organizing Committee will assist where possible, but interviews cannot be guaranteed.
- Media representatives must respect athletes' competition schedules, recovery time and the instructions of team officials.

### 6. Press services and on-site procedures

- Information on accreditation collection, daily sign-in, press seating, photographers' positions and press-room opening hours will be sent to approved media before the event.
- Media representatives are responsible for their own personal equipment and connectivity unless otherwise communicated.
- Credentials must be worn visibly at all times in controlled areas and may be withdrawn if event rules or staff instructions are not respected.
