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1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Jelgava Cup** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2025, Competition & Event Regulations 2026, Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Jelgava Cup** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Competition & Event Regulations 2026, Article 7.2, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Article 9.3.1, and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirement in Article 8 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Article 8 and ISU Communication 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

	Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.
JUNIOR WOMEN	Short Program	The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.
	Free Skating	In accordance with ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the “well balanced program” and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

3. ENTRIES

All Entries to the Jelgava Cup must be done through the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) by the deadline indicated.

The deadline for entries is October 5th , 2026

4. APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS

This International Figure Skating event will follow the requirements of CER Article 14.2.1, ISU Communication 2780 and principles of Rule 420, paragraph 5.a) of the ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026 for appointing the Event Officials.

The members of each individual Technical Panel (Technical Controller and the Technical Specialists) will not be from the same ISU Member. At the members of the Technical Panel will have qualification of "International" or "ISU" level.

The Referee will have at least the qualification "International" and could be of the same ISU Member as one member of the Technical Panel (Technical Controller and Technical Specialists).

The Data Operator and the Replay Operator will have at least the qualification "International".

5. MUSIC AND PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on USB flash drive or send it to jcmusic@inbox.lv

Each file shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name of the competitor.

6. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 352 and Rule 353 will be used.

7. AWARDS

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honored and awarded by Trophies. All the skaters will receive memory presents at the accreditation desk. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please note that only top 3 skaters are represented at the award ceremony.

8. INSURANCE AND LIABILITIES

In accordance with Article 17.3, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance. The ISU and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred incurred by Competitors or Officials in connection with the event.

9. ACCOMODATION

There is no Official Hotel at this event. Teams are requested to organise their accomodation by themselves. The OC will organise accomodation to Invited Event Officials only.
