1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Pavel Roman Memorial 2026** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution 2025, Competition & Event Regulations 2026, Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, and the relevant ISU Communications.

The Pavel Roman Memorial 2026 Ice Dance International is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to ISU Rule. 7 of the CER and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements Rule 8.1 and 8.2 of the CER and ISU Communication 2526, or any update of this Communication. Passports of all skaters as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate (if applicable) must be presented at accreditation. In accordance with ISU Rule 8.3 of the CER, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. All participants accept that personal data is collected by the Organizing Committee (OC) and such data is stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of, and to the extent necessary only in relation to facilitate their participation in the competition; personal data may include but will not be limited to full legal name as per national identity documents, address, date of birth, nationality, gender.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

2.2.1. Senior Ice Dance

Rhythm Dance

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 709. Rhythms, required elements, and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 2795 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2795 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

2.2.2. Junior Ice Dance

Rhythm Dance

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 709. Rhythms, required elements, and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 2795 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 50 sec. +/- 10 sec

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2795 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

2.2.3. Advanced Novice Ice Dance

Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules 2026, Rule 711. Patterns, music requirements, required elements and other guidelines are

published in ISU Communication 2794 and any subsequent updates. Pattern dances will be called with Key Points. The following pattern dances are to be skated:

- **Paso Doble Plus:** 2 sequences of Paso Doble and 1 Choreographic element, performed in any order, with a maximum duration of 1 minute 10 seconds.
- **Blues:** 2 sequences

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules 2026, Rule 710. Required elements and other guidelines are published in ISU Communication 2794 and any subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 minutes ± 10 seconds

2.2.4. Intermediate Novice Ice Dance

Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules 2026, Rule 711. Patterns, music requirements, required elements and other guidelines are published in ISU Communication 2794 and any subsequent updates. Pattern dances will be called with Key Points. The following pattern dances are to be skated:

- **Fourteenstep:** 2 sequences
- **Foxtrot:** 2 sequences

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules 2026, Rule 710. Required elements and other guidelines are published in ISU Communication 2794 and any subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

2.2.5. Basic Novice Ice Dance

Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules 2026, Rule 711. Patterns, music requirements, required elements and other guidelines are published in ISU Communication 2794 and any subsequent updates. Pattern dances will be called with Key Points. The following pattern dances are to be skated:

- **Willow Waltz:** 2 sequences
- **Tango Fiesta:** 2 sekquences

Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Sports Rules 2026, Rule 710. Required elements and other guidelines are published in ISU Communication 2794 and any subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

3. ENTRIES

3.1. Entries by name

3.1.1. General

All Entries for Pavel Roman Memorial must be made by the ISU Members and/or clubs and must be done through the **ISU Online Registration System (ORS)** by the deadline indicated. Hotel and travel information should also be entered into ORS. Declaration will need to be uploaded to the ORS as well.

3.1.3. Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate one Judge with the qualification of at least Judge for International competitions for the event. The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration system (ORS) and reach the Organizing Committee and the Czech Figure Skating Association, **not later than Wednesday, October 7th, 2026.**

Accommodation and meals beginning with dinner on Friday November, 6th until breakfast on Monday November 9th, 2026 will be covered for this judges by the organizer.

3.1.4. Entries of Team Members

The names of all team members (Coaches, Team Leaders and all other chaperones) must be submitted via the ISU Online Registration System and must reach the Organizing Committee **not later than Wednesday, October 7th, 2026.**

4. ENTRY FEE

The entry fees for all entries are as follows:

€ 160,00 per couple

Payment must be made in advance not later than Wednesday, October 7th, 2026. If a couple withdraws from the competition after October 7th, 2026, the entry fee will not be refunded.

Entries will not be accepted, if the Entry Fee has not arrived at the Organizers account in time.

Entries will not be accepted, if the Entry Fee has not arrived at the Organizers account in time.

5. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The Organizer will cover the expenses for provided rooms and meals for the invited Officials and for one judge from each participating country beginning with dinner on Friday November, 6th until breakfast on Monday November 9th, 2026. Travel expenses will be paid only to the invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators, based on the economy fare.

All Competitors, and Team Leaders have to bear their own expenses.

6. PRACTICE

Official practices for Competitors begin on Friday, November, 6th, 2026 after the Opening Ceremony. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of the registration. All the practices will be realized in groups as drawn.

7. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

8. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

Music will be played from digital mp3 files. The files with music must each participating couple send to email ilona.sogelova@email.cz till Tuesday, October 20th, 2026 latest. The file name must clearly state full names of the competitors, program, country and the category, in which the couple is entered.

The titles composer and orchestras of the music to be used for the Pattern, Rhythm and free Dances must all be entered, in detail, by the ISU Member or the Skaters on the dedicated ISU Platform.

Each Couple must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each Program in the MP3 format. Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skaters on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Couples in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

ISU Members/Skaters are reminded that in order for them to use music to accompany their routines, the following 'Music Accompaniment' rights/ licenses are required:

- the right to edit or adapt music into a mix, if more than one song is being used.

- the right to set choreography to the music, often referred to as a ‘Grand Right’, which is the right to perform musical compositions and recordings within the context of a "dramatic work” or choreography.
- the right to create any copies of the music that may be needed for training and competition purposes, also known as the ‘mechanical rights’.

In order for a music to be fully cleared for these uses, these rights need to be cleared for each and every track used in each mix that contains a license (backed by a warranty and legal indemnity) for the territory of the Czech Republic that covers both the master rights of the recording artist and the publishing rights of each individual writer and composer of the track.

9. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS

All participants are requested to announce to Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but no later than Wednesday October 7th, 2026 the all information of your arrival. The detailed travel information needs to be submitted via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS).

Recommended ways of travelling:

By train from Prague (the International Vaclav Havel Airport Prague) to Olomouc.

By train from the nearest airports of Ostrava (Leoš Janáček Airport, the former Mošnov Airport) and Brno to Olomouc (the distance of 76, respectively 80 kilometres to cover).

Organizer will not provide any transport for participants.

10. OFFICIAL HOTEL

The official Hotel of 31st Pavel Roman Memorial will be the Flora Hotel in Olomouc. The Hotel is located in a quiet street, near the city centre, within a walking distance from the Ice Rink.

11. ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation will be for all participants (Referees, Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators, Judges, Competitors, Coaches and other Team Members) at the Flora Hotel **on Friday, November 6th, 2026 from 13:30 to 15:30 hours.**

The Opening Ceremony and Opening Draws will be held at the Flora Hotel at 17:30 hours.

12. JUDGES MEETING

The initial judges meeting and draw will be **at the Flora Hotel on Friday, November 6th, 2026 at 16:00 hours** for all Judges, Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data & Replay Operators.

The Round Table Discussions are scheduled for Sunday, November 8th, 2026 after the competition.

13. AWARDS

The couples placed in the first three places in each category will obtain cups; all the participants will be presented with diplomas.

14. VICTORY CEREMONY

All the participants will be invited to the ice during the final Victory Ceremony.

15. BANQUET

The final banquet will take place in the café room in Hotel Flora on Sunday November 8th, 2026 at 7:30 p. m. All official guests and judges are being invited to the banquet. Other participants can buy the banquet tickets (30 € per person) during the Accreditation time or later, during the competition, in Organizing Committee Office on Ice Rink.

16. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.
