ISU Short Track World Tour 2024/25 held at the Utah Olympic Oval, Salt Lake City - USA on November 1-3, 2024

General Regulations

The competitions will be held under the 2024 ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations/Technical Rules for Short Track Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2648.

Participation is open to all ISU Members. This competition is part of the ISU Short Track World Tour 2024/25.

Track Conditions

The Utah Olympic Oval has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. A fully movable protective padding system in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2626 (or any further update). The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

Entries¹

- a) Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) for World Cup Short Track Speed Skating on https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login
- b) Entries with the number of Competitors, substitutes, coaches & Team leader and requirements of accommodation must be submitted by **September 20, 2024.**

The number of other personnel travelling with the Team shall be communicated at the same time ISU Members failing to comply in time with these requirements will receive no support from the Organizing Member for:

- Hotel booking;
- Travel arrangements between airport and hotel;
- Travel arrangements between hotel and ice rink;
- Preferred times for additional training sessions.

All these costs and any additional costs incurred will be for the full account of the ISU Members concerned.

- c) Final Entries must reach the Organizing Committee using the Online Registration System must be submitted at the latest by 20:00 hrs (local time) on **Tuesday, October 22, 2024** (see ISU Communication No. 2648, paragraph 5), and the following information must be communicated to the Organizing Committee:
 - Names of the Competitors and a list of alternate names per category with their International Registration Numbers
 - Names of the Competitors and their personal best time, recorded during the period of eligibility, for all individual distances they might participate in
 - Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances;
 - Confirmation of participation in all the competitions of the Relay.

Only the Competitors listed on the Final Entry, respecting the maximum number of entries allowed, can attend and receive an accreditation for the Event.

Final Entries that do not comply with these requirements are considered Post Entries. See Rule 115.

- d) Competitors must be present in Salt Lake City at the latest at 18:00 hours on Thursday, October 31 or the Organizing Committee must receive documented proof that the competitors are in transit and will arrive in due time for the World Tour Competition. Competitors who do not comply with these requirements will be excluded
- e) Please note that for all persons entered by the Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628 need to be strictly observed. Declaration Forms must be uploaded in

the ORS in each Competitors and Team Officials' profile prior submitting the Entries.

Citizenships/Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

World Tour points

The points scoring at the World Tour is made in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2648, paragraphs 10, 11 and 12.

Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications Nos. 2344 & 2366 or later updates).

Ice Training

The Organizing Committee will arrange free ice for Official Training on Thursday, October 31 for all participating teams. Additional practices will be provided on Tuesday, October 29 and Wednesday, October 30. Each training session (50min) will be charged \$20 per skater per session. Request for training preferences (teams) will be accepted until Monday, October 21. The Organizing Committee will try to accommodate those requests if possible. Monday afternoon, October 27, training is available upon request ONLY. No transportation will be provided on Monday. Alternative options are Uber, Lyft, Taxi.

Weight Training & Dryland

Weight room is limited to 12-15 athletes per session. Weight room is open from Tuesday to Thursday 8:00-17:00 and during competition times. Reservation is required and can ONLY be made by reserving ONE time slot per day. Link for reservation will be provided in the TL information package.

Liability

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, US Speedskating and The Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the ISU Short Track World Tour Competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Entry Visa Requirements

Should you need assistance to obtain a USA entry visa or require a specific letter of invitation, please contact the Organizing Committee.

Accommodation

All participants shall bear their own expenses for accommodation.

The cost of a room and meal at the official hotel is as follows:

Single Room (per person, per night, full board): 257.70 US\$ (including tax)

Hotel Terms:

- Rooms must be booked no later than September 20, 2024
- A 50% down payment of anticipated room cost has to be made not later than 30 days prior to arrival
- Teams paying with credit card(s) will be subject to bear credit card charges
- A late payment fee of 5% will be added for teams who have not settled their invoices within 15 days of departure
- Rooms can be cancelled free of charge until October 7. After October 7, each cancelled room will be charged at 80% of the anticipated revenue.
