On behalf of Speed Skating Canada, the Organizing Committee has the honor and pleasure to invite you to a competition in the

ISU Short Track World Tour 2024/25 which will be held at the Maurice-Richard Arena, Montreal, Canada October 25-27, 2024

General Regulations

The competitions will be held under the 2024 ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations/Technical Rules for Short Track Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2648. Participation is open to all ISU Members. This competition is part of the ISU Short Track World Tour 2024/25.

Track Conditions

The Maurice-Richard Arena has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2626 (or any further update). The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

Entries¹

a) Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) for World Cup Short Track Speed Skating on https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login

b) Entries with the number of Competitors, substitutes, coaches & Team leader and requirements of accommodation must be submitted by **September 13**, **2024**.

The number of other personnel travelling with the Team shall be communicated at the same time

ISU Members failing to comply in time with these requirements will receive no support from the Organizing Member for:

- Hotel booking;
- Travel arrangements between airport and hotel;
- Travel arrangements between hotel and ice rink;
- Access to Closing Banquet (if held);
- Preferred times for additional training sessions.

All these costs and any additional costs incurred will be for the full account of the ISU Members concerned.

c) Final Entries **must reach** the Organizing Committee using the Online Registration System must be submitted at the latest by 20:00 hrs (local time) on **October 15**, **2024**. (see ISU Communication No. 2648, paragraph 5), and the following information must be communicated to the Organizing Committee:

- Names of the Competitors and a list of alternate names per category with their International Registration Numbers
- Names of the Competitors and their personal best time, recorded during the period of eligibility, for all individual distances they might participate in
- Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances;
- Confirmation of participation in all the competitions of the Relay.

Only the Competitors listed on the Final Entry, respecting the maximum number of entries allowed, can attend and receive an accreditation for the Event.

Final Entries that do not comply with these requirements are considered Post Entries. See Rule 115.

d) Competitors must be present in Montreal at the latest at 18:00 hours on **Thursday, October 24** or the Organizing Committee must receive documented proof that the competitors are in transit and will arrive in due time for the World Tour Competition. Competitors who do not comply with these requirements will be excluded

e) Please note that for all persons entered by the Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628 need to be strictly observed. Declaration Forms must be uploaded in the ORS in each Competitors and Team Officials' profile prior submitting the Entries.

¹ Reference is made to ISU Communication No. 2469, paragraph 2.a) according to which and until further notice, no individual belonging to the Russian Skating Union and Skating Union of Belarus shall be invited, entered and allowed to participate in International Competitions, ISU Championships and other ISU Events.

Citizenships/Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

World Tour points

The points scoring at the World Tour is made in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2648, paragraphs 10, 11 and 12.

Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications Nos. 2344 & 2366 or later updates).

Ice Training

The Organizing Committee will arrange free ice for Official Training on Thursday, October 24 for all participating teams. Extra Official practices will be provided from October 21st. Each training session (50 minutes) will be charged \$20.00 CAD.

Additional dry training possibilities (i.e. weight room) is available at the Maurice-Richard arena, basement floor. Free of charge. Reservation is required. Requests must be done by email to Jill Lynch worldcup@speedskating.ca no later than October 10, 2024.

Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Accommodation

All participants should bear their own expenses for accommodation. The cost of a room and meal at the official hotel is as follows:

Rooms

The cost of a room (1 to 4 persons per room) is as follows:

Room with 1 King bed or 2 double beds \$195.00 + taxes (Lodging 3.5% + TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975 %) = \$235.05 CAD (per night):

*Payment: Cash; in CAD or Credit card; (Visa, Master Card, American Express) or Bank Transfer

Meals

Breakfast: 18.00 + taxes and services (TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975% + Services 18%) = \$24.43 CAD / per person Lunch: <math>25.00 + taxes and services (TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975% + Services 18%) = 33.91 CAD / per person Dinner: <math>27.00 + taxes and services (TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975% + Services 18%) = 36.63 CAD / per person *Full payment must be done before or upon arrival to receive meals coupons.

Participating ISU Members will be required to arrange a pre-payment of 100 % of the total hotel rooms cost **not** later than October 14, 2024.

In case of no-shows or cancellation of hotel rooms after **October 15**, the ISU Member concerned will be charged 80% of the total costs by the Organizing Committee.

Transportation

The Organizing Committee will organize and provide one transportation each way, free of charge, for each team between Airport Montreal Trudeau (YUL) and the official hotels, from Sunday, October 20 to Monday, October 28th, 2024.

Expenses for team officials, who do not accompany their team members, are to be borne by themselves \$100.00 CAD

The Organizing Committee will also provide transportation between the official hotel and Maurice-Richard Arena during the competition days and the training periods, starting from Monday, October 21st, 2024.

The date, airline, flight number, expected time of arrival and the date and time of departure should be communicated to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible, but **no later than October 15**. Please include the amount of special equipment (e.g. bicycles, massage tables, etc.) that needs to be transported.

Water Bottles

Plastic water bottles will not be provided by the Organizing Committee. Teams are asked to bring their own reusable water bottles and to use the refill stations at the venue
