which will be held at the National Speed Skating Oval (Ice Ribbon) in Beijing, China on November 29 to December 1, 2024

The Competition will be held under the 2024 ISU General Regulations, Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2653.

This World Cup Competition will serve as one of the qualifying events for quota places at the ISU European Speed Skating Championships 2024.

This World Cup Competition will serve as one of the qualifying events for quota places at the ISU World Speed Skating Championships 2024, Single Distances & Team Competitions format.

* The actual starting times for the B Division races will be announced during the Online Team leaders' meetings. For each distance, the races of Division A and the races of Division B are considered as two separate

competitions with independent final classifications (list of results) for determining the awarding of World Cup points and prize money.

TRACK

National Speed Skating Oval (Ice Ribbon) is an indoor artificially frozen ice rink with a standard track of 400 meters and inner and outer curves with radii of 26 meters and 30 meters respectively. The width of the inside training track is [5] meters. In accordance with Rue 228 a protective moveable padding system will be installed around the track.

ENTRIES

Entries for these competitions will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraph 3.1.

Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events on <u>https://ssk-entries.isu.org/</u> and respecting the following deadlines:

Preliminary Entries & Accommodation Requests	October 29
Accreditation Requests for Teams	October 29
Travel Dates & Transportation Requests	October 29
Final Entries	November 25 – 12.00 noon (local time)

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628, need to be strictly observed.

For more details, please refer to Rules 115, 131 and ISU Communications No. 1628 and 1797 or any update of this Communications.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

According to ISU Communication No. 2653, the entry quotas (maximum number of entries per distance, subject to the qualifying times criteria) for this competition are:

ISU Speed Skating Members not listed in the table above, may enter a maximum of 1 Skater for each distance¹.

All entered Skaters (incl. substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances according to the criteria given in Communication No. 2653, paragraph 3.1.2.

¹ Reference is made to ISU Communication No. 2469, paragraph 2.a) according to which and until further notice, no individual belonging to the Russian Skating Union and Skating Union of Belarus shall be invited, entered and allowed to participate in International Competitions, ISU Championships and other ISU Events.

COMPETITION FORMAT AND SAFETY MEASURES FOR THE MASS START EVENTS

Mass Start races will be skated according to Rule 257 and Rule 265, paragraph 6 in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraph 5.6, with distances of 16 laps for both Women and Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2651 or any further updates.

COMPETITION FORMAT FOR THE TEAM SPRINT EVENTS

Team Sprint races will be skated according to Rule 256, paragraph 2 and Rule 265, paragraph 7 in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraphs 4.2 and 5.7, with teams of 3 Skaters each, and with distances of 3 laps both for Women and for Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2651 or any further updates.

GROUPING AND DRAWING PROCEDURES

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be made according to ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraph 5.

PRIZES AND POINTS

For each event, World Cup points and prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2653, paragraphs 6 and 7.2 accordingly.

ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track and gym facilities will be open for training for entered Competitors from [Monday, November 25]. Trial starts will be organized on Thursday, November 28 10:00-10:45 and 11:00-11:45.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

ISU Members may ask for changes in the training schedule (published in the Inside ISU Events' App) latest by November 22. Decisions on changes' request will be taken by the Organizing Committee in consultation with the ISU.

LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, [Chinese Skating Association] and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage incurred in connection with the ISU World Cup Speed Skating. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

ACCOMMODATION

Participating ISU Members will have to bear expenses for accommodation for all participating Skaters and team officials.

The cost of a room and meals at the official hotel(s) will be as follows (including all taxes):

Single Room occupancy: 1200 RMB per room per night. Price including meals and drinks. Double Room occupancy; 1800 RMB per room per night. Price including meals and drinks.

Cancellation policy:

(1) October 25, 2024: hotel reservation information must be submitted before this date, ISU Member federations will be required to pay 50% of the total booking as a deposit before October 29 upon receipt of the invoice.

(2) From October 26 to November 11, 2024: 20% of the rooms booked can be canceled free of charge.

- (3) November 15, 2024: Deadline to pay the remaining booking.
- (4) From November 16, 2024: 100% of the room rate will be charged for room cancellation.

Accommodation requests can only be made directly with the Organizing Committee via the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

Payment:

Payments shall be made via bank transfer. If any additional reservation is needed after November 16, the participants can pay by credit card (Visa, Master, JCB) at the hotel. Any handling fees incurred during the payment process shall be borne by the payer.

OFFICIAL HOTEL(S)

The Organizing Committee will make hotel reservation for the teams in the following hotel:

Beijing Continental Grand Hotel Address: No.8 Beichen East Road, Chaoyang District, Beijing *as a hotel for competitors and the ISU

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of hotel rooms available to each team at the official hotel(s). The standard price is in RMB and payment by teams shall be made based on the RMB/EUR exchange rate on the date of pay

TRANSPORTATION

Information about the date and time of arrival and departure (incl. flight details) of the competitors and team officials must be submitted via the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events.

Airport pick-up and drop-off:

Based on actual needs, the Organizing Committee will arrange shuttle bus service for participating teams from November 22 to 28. The pick-up and drop-off locations are

- Beijing Capital International Airport (closer to the venue, please keep it as the primary choice)
- Beijing Daxing International Airport

(1) Rate: One-way: 240RMB per person

(2) Service request submission: If you need pick-up or drop-off services at the airport, please send the arrival and departure date and time, flight number and other relevant information to the Organizing Committee via ISU OES before October 25, and complete the payment. If you are bringing large luggage (e.g., bicycle, massage table, etc.), please indicate the luggage type and quantity in the OES system.

(3) Please note: If any member of a participating team chooses to go by themselves, they can take a taxi at the airport. The taxi should be paid in cash in RMB, credit card payment is not supported; if the ISU marketing agencies or sponsors need the Organizing Committee to provide paid pick-up and drop-off services, please provide relevant information via OES system.

Transport between hotel and venue:

From November 25 to December 1, the Organizing Committee will provide free shuttle bus service for participating teams between the official hotel (competitors and ISU) and the venue, and media shuttles will be provided between the media hotel and the venue.

The organizer is not obliged to provide services (accommodation, accredited entrance to the ice rink, transportation, etc.) for an excessive number of team officials or other accompanying persons from participating ISU Members. A fee of EUR 250 for each additional Team Officials/Federation Officials accreditation must be paid to the Organizing Committee.
